CHILDREN NEEDING SPONSORS IN ODISHA

These children desperately need sponsors. Each one of them is an orphan – with both parents deceased or with one parent deceased, and the other parent abandoning them. The village elders in each case, recognizing the dire conditions they were in, brought them to AGPV residential school. While the school is only set up for fifty children, these little ones could not be turned away. Their basic needs are being met but each day it is getting harder to stretch the money to meet all seventy-two children's needs.
