#### Section 2. Duties of the President

The President shall be the Chief Executive of the Club. The President shall preside at all meetings of the members and shall have the responsibility for the general control and management of all Club activities. He is responsible for the care and custody of all Club property and shall maintain an up-to-date record of all such property, which shall include the name of any member charged with temporary custody thereof. He may call special meetings under the provisions of Article III. He shall be an ex-office member of all committees and preside at the Board of Officers meeting in the absence of the Vice President. Other responsibilities include regular communication with the other officers and committee chairmen to ensure coordination of functions and successful completion of activities. He shall appoint a parliamentarian and web master on a yearly basis or as necessary. (amended 2/23/2002)

#### Section 3. Duties of the Vice President

In the absence of the President or in case of his death, resignation or inability to act (which will be determined by the Board of Officers), the duties usually appertaining to that office shall be performed by the Vice President. He shall serve as Chairman of the monthly officers meeting. He shall serve as Director of social and noncompetitive activities. He shall also actively promote the name of N.R.L. in the community.

#### Section 4. Duties of the Secretary

The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the members and officers and shall record all minutes and the outcome of all votes in a book kept for this purpose. He shall give all notices of meetings to the members required by law or these bylaws and shall perform all duties incidental to this office required by law or the majority vote of the officers. He shall have custody of the Club's records and keep all Club correspondence. He shall be responsible for absentee voting as detailed in Article IV, Section 2 and Article IX. In the absence of the Secretary from any meeting, a Secretary pro tempore shall be chosen by the presiding Officer. The Secretary shall also act as Club Historian.

#### **Section 5. Duties of the Treasurer**

The Treasurer shall, subject to such conditions and restrictions as may be made by the officers, have custody of all monies, debts, and obligations belonging to the Club. He shall receive monies for the Club and deposit it in the Club account. He shall mail all payments of club debts upon approval of the Board of Officers. All CONTRACTS, CHECKS, DRAFTS, NOTES OR OTHER ORDERS FOR PAYMENT OF MONEY SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE TREASURER AND PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT. If these three positions are held by the same member, another co-signer will be selected by the Board of Officers. He shall give bond at Club expense. (amended July 2006)

The Treasurer shall give a report on the financial status of the Club at the monthly meeting, and, if so requested, at any other meeting of the Officers. No obligation, debt or other liability shall be incurred by the Treasurer without the specific approval of the Board of Officers.

The Treasurer shall also be responsible for maintaining the Corporate and Not-For-Profit status of the Club.

#### Section 8. Duties of the Membership Director

The Membership Director shall be charged with the responsibility for keeping up-to-date records of all members. He shall keep track of the number of functions attended by prospective members and active members. He shall be in charge of collecting monies due for membership, both initial and renewal. He shall be in charge of selling club property at the Club function. He shall be responsible for contacting all prospective members who have expressed an interest in Club membership.

#### **Section 9. Duties of the Publication Director**

The Publication Director shall be in charge of Club news publication. He shall be the Editor, Writer, Publisher and distributor of this publication. At his discretion he may designate any or all of these functions to volunteers. If done so, he shall be final authority and hold full responsibility for this publication, within reason.

#### Section 2. Duties of the President

The President shall be the Chief Executive of the Club. The President shall preside at all meetings of the members and shall have the responsibility for the general control and management of all Club activities. He is responsible for the care and custody of all Club property and shall maintain an up-to-date record of all such property, which shall include the name of any member charged with temporary custody thereof. He may call special meetings under the provisions of Article III. He shall be an ex-officio member of all committees and preside at the Board of Officers meeting in the absence of the Vice President. Other responsibilities include regular communication with the other officers and committee chairmen to ensure coordination of functions and successful completion of activities. He shall appoint a parliamentarian and web master on a yearly basis or as necessary. (amended 2/23/2002)

#### Section 3. <u>Duties of the Vice President</u>

In the absence of the President or in case of his death, resignation or inability to act (which will be determined by the Board of Officers), the duties usually appertaining to that office shall be performed by the Vice President. He shall serve as Chairman of any Board of Officers meeting. He shall serve as Director of social and noncompetitive activities. He shall also actively promote the name of N.R.L. in the community.

#### Section 4. Duties of the Secretary

The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the members and officers and shall record all minutes and the outcome of all votes. He shall submit for publishing in the newsletter or by email to all members who have provided an email address. He shall give all notices of meetings to the members required by law or these bylaws and shall perform all duties incidental to this office required by law or the majority vote of the officers. He shall have custody of the Club's records and keep all Club correspondence. He shall be responsible for absentee voting as detailed in Article IV, Section 2 and Article IX. In the absence of the Secretary from any meeting, a Secretary pro tempore shall be chosen by the presiding Officer. The Secretary shall also act as Club Historian.

#### Section 5. <u>Duties of the Treasurer</u>

The Treasurer shall, subject to such conditions and restrictions as may be made by the officers, have custody of all monies, debts, and obligations belonging to the Club. He shall receive monies for the Club and deposit it in the Club account. He shall mail all payments of club debts upon approval of the Board of Officers. All CONTRACTS, CHECKS, DRAFTS, NOTES OR OTHER ORDERS FOR PAYMENT OF MONEY SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE TREASURER AND PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT. If these three positions are held by the same member, another co-signer will be selected by the Board of Officers. Also, a co-signer may not be of the same household or related by blood or marriage to the Treasurer. If this should occur, another co-signer will be selected by the Board of Officers.

He shall give bond at Club expense. (amended July 2006)

The Treasurer shall prepare a budget for approval by the Board of Officers. Any payments within 10% of the budgeted amount or not exceeding \$25 of the budgeted amount may be paid by the Treasurer. If an obligation does not meet these criteria, the payment must be approved by the Board of Officers. The Treasurer shall give a report on the financial status of the Club at the monthly meeting, and, if so requested, at any other meeting of the Officers. No obligation, debt or other liability shall be incurred by the Treasurer without the specific approval of the Board of Officers.

The Treasurer shall also be responsible for maintaining the Corporate and Not-For-Profit status of the Club.







#### Calibrating the Tire Pressure Sensors on a C5 Corvette

Starting with the 1997 model year Corvettes were equipped with run flat tires and the new tire pressure monitor system or TPMS. The tire pressure sensors are located inside the tire valve stems. (There is a picture at the bottom of this page).

If you have new tires, put on your Corvette, you may have to recalibrate the tire pressure sensors. The only tool you need is a big magnet. I used one from the back of an old speaker. You will also have to utilize the Driver Information Center or "DIC" to access the "Tire Training" Mode. The 'DIC" is in the area of your instrument panel where the odometer is displayed. The Procedure is as follows:

1) Turn ignition on 2) Press "Reset" button in order to clear any IPC display warning messages 3) Press and release the "Options" button on the DIC to scroll through the display options until the IPC display is blank 4) Press and hold the DIC "Reset" button for 3 seconds 5) Press the "Options" button again until TIRE TRAINING message appears 6) Press "Reset" button until the IPC "Learn L Front Tire" message appears in order to begin the programming 7) Hold a large magnet over the left front valve stem 8) The horn will sound, indicating the left front TPM sensor is programmed (if this takes more than 15 seconds, pull magnet back and try again, it will give you three tries. Then you must start over) 9) When the horn sounds, proceed to program the next TPM sensor in the following order as directed by the IPC messages: -Learn R Front Tire -Learn R Rear Tire -Learn L Rear Tire Programming can be canceled by turning ignition off, waiting 2 minutes with no sensors being learned, finishing all 4 wheels or through the DIC. If the programming is canceled with less than 4 sensors learned, it will only accept the codes programmed up to that point.


