And this is how it really started...

Ten years ago, I was lost and without hope in a narcissistic marriage when God called me to, "Finish the book and get the divorce." I knew this was my "green-light-go" Word from the Lord, and I wanted out of the bondage I was living. But how?

I had a master's degree in divinity, and an MBA, so knowledge was not the problem. I owned a counseling center with my husband, but he held all the cards. I was afraid to do anything on my own because he would turn off my phone if I wouldn't do what he said. Or he would turn off my phone or hold back money I earned if I did something he did not like. This happened often and I had no contact with friends or family. This obviously worried loved ones as they were not able to contact me until my phone was turned back on. This was not a loving marriage. This was control. This was bondage. This was the life I lived with three children in school. But the Lord gave me a plan...

After dropping off the children at school, I would walk a dam in our neighborhood. I would pray in English and in the spirit. God would give me revelation and I would go home and write my chapters in my book and make the phone calls I needed to make.

It was during this very stressful time that the Lord gave me keys to living in His kingdom here on earth, and I began to live them out and write them in my book, Rising Above – Dealing With Our Past, Making Way For Our Future.

It was during this time that I had an epiphany and stated it in the very first paragraph in my book:

"We as a human race unknowingly cooperate with our enemy and without question become oblivious to the power this enemy holds over us. We may be believers in God, but we have problems. We are called to be at the head and not the tail and yet more of us are at the tail than the head. Why?"

Part of the answer to this question is in Deuteronomy 28:13-14, where God tells us:

"The Lord will make you the head, not the tail. If you *pay attention to the commands of the LORD* your God that I give you this day and *carefully follow them*, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. Do not turn aside from any of the commands I give you today, to the right or to the left, following other gods and serving them." (Emphasis mine.)

Some people might say, this is old fashioned, or this is Old Testament. Well, let me tell you

friend, our Lord is the same yesterday, today, and forever. First, we are to pay attention to the commands of the LORD and then we are to carefully follow them.

What are the commands you might ask? The 10 commandments, the words and promises of Jesus, and other scriptures found in the Bible for starters. His commands are also the words He speaks to us through the Holy Spirit, our comforter, the Christ in us.

Jesus told us to seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all things will be added unto us (Matthew 6:33). He also said, the kingdom of God is within (Luke 17:20-21). So, how does all of this go together?

I'm going to tell you how.

Spiritual Keys are Found in the Bible

So, what are the keys to living in the kingdom of God here on earth? The first key is:

1. Having a relationship with Jesus.

John 3:16 tells us. "For God so love the world that He gave His only begotten son that whosoever believes in Him, should not perish but have eternal life."

Without Jesus we are a lost people. Jesus paid the ultimate price for everyone's sins. It is because of Jesus' blood sacrifice of His own life that not only do we have an opportunity to have eternal life by our repentance of sins and confession of Jesus as our Savior, but we also receive Christ living in us, right here and right now.

If the devil knew this was the plan of the Father, then he would never have orchestrated Jesus' death on the cross. The devil thought he outsmarted God Almighty. However, Jesus was the sacrificial lamb for all mankind. Now Christ lives in us. When we listen to his guidance, we live with Him in His kingdom here on earth.

Remember, Jesus said the kingdom of God is within. When we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us, we are literally making Jesus our Lord, and not just our Savior. This is HUGE! Why is it huge? Because we are hearkening unto the voice of the Lord, our triune God, which leads to the next key...

2. Pay attention to the commands of the LORD and carefully follow them.

Why is this the second key? Because we forget. We live our life. We think we can handle life without including God or His ways. We follow the ways of our own thoughts, or the ways of society and think it's not a big deal. But it is. God told us way back in Deuteronomy to pay attention and carefully follow the commands of the Lord.

He wasn't kidding then and He isn't kidding now.

Hosea 4:6 tells us that we are destroyed from a lack of knowledge or knowing God intimately. You see, God wants a relationship with us. He doesn't want us to know about Him. He wants us to KNOW Him.

And get this, God also said, "because you have ignored the law of your God, I also will ignore your children." WOW! Why? Because our kids learn by our example. If we are the example of following other ways of the world, that is exactly what our kids learn – from us. Thank God there is a way to remedy this! How? You might ask?

3. Repentance of our sins.

When we honestly repent of our sins from our heart and soul, and ask God to forgive us, He does. This is a spiritual principle and a spiritual act. As we repent for our sins, we are released from the guilt because we received mercy and grace. We feel this in our body - in the natural. Everything we do in the spiritual we see manifested in the natural as we keep the faith and *use our words* stating our faith.

We might have some consequences, but the guilt is gone. We are refreshed. We take off our old coat of sin and put on a white robe of light, and love.

If a sin comes back to our mind, then we can remind our enemy that we left that sin at the cross, because we are forgiven. For God so loved the world that He gave His only son for our redemption. As God loved us, so shall we love others and forgive them. Which brings me to our next key...

4. Love.

As we acknowledge Jesus as our Savior, and how Christ lives in us because of Jesus' love for us, we ought to love ourselves and one another. As we believe in the guidance we are receiving from Christ and support others in how the Holy Spirit is guiding them, we are doing our best to keep the unity of the Spirit of God in the bond of peace.

Let's face it, we don't always want to love. Sometimes we hold grudges, hate, spite, and verbally abuse people we are supposed to love. Hmmm. But according to 1 Corinthians 13:4, "love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant."

And 1 John 4:19 says, "We love because he first loved us." Another scripture I want to focus on is John 15:12 when Jesus said, "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you." Listen, if Jesus is telling us that this is *His commandment* to us, then we need

to listen up and take note. We need to give thanks to God for showing us **how to remain** in unity, and in His kingdom.

Jesus said, "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you," John 15:12.

Loving each other keeps us in unity and in the kingdom of God mindset. The battle is in our mind which is why we are told, "...let this mind be in you which is also in Christ Jesus," Philippians 2:5. If we are told, "let this mind be in you..." then...

This means it is possible to have the mind of Christ. How? -> Read the scriptures, pray with all types of prayers, including in the spirit, and listen for Christ to speak to us directly. This takes us to the next key of living in the kingdom of God here on earth.

5. With love, we pray from our heart and forgive ourselves and others

Many of us know forgiveness is for ourselves, to unlatch the chains that bind us and keep us from moving forward because of bitterness, and unforgiveness. In the book of 1 John 4:20 it tells us, "Whoever claims to love God yet hates a brother or sister is a liar. For whoever does not love their brother and sister, whom they have seen, cannot love God, whom they have not seen."

Trust me, I know this can be super hard for many people. It was certainly a hard one for me! How many times do I need to forgive? How many days, weeks, months, years? Well according to scripture, 70 x 7 times a day. So, when we have done our part, we wait for a Word from our Lord.

A couple of scriptures helped me stay focused on my relationship with the Lord so I could stay the course. Mark 11:25 says, "Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."

You see, our requests to God directly correlate with whether we have forgiven someone. If we don't forgive, how can God forgive us and give us what we ask? If we do forgive however, our

prayers are not hindered. We can live with the kingdom of God mindset here on earth. We also want to remember Galatians 5:14 which states, "For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

Another scripture passage I find directly related to forgiveness and living in the kingdom of God here on earth is Matthew 5:25.

"Therefore, if you bring your gift (tithe/offering) to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift."

You see, our tithing and repentance/forgiveness are also directly connected and correlated with each other. Which brings me to another key.

6. Tithes and offerings

Some Christians don't want to tithe, meaning give 10 percent of their income. Some don't want to give an offering even when led by God.

Primarily it's because they don't want to let go of the money they have earned or oversee. They might think it's more important to pay bills or save. In my humble opinion, they do this because they either don't know the principles or tithing/offerings. The don't know the scriptures. Or, they don't have faith in God's promises. Jesus tells us we can't serve two masters meaning God or mammon, the god of money. We must make a choice and this my friend is where the rubber meets the road.

Malachi 3:10 says, "'Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,' says the LORD Almighty, 'and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.'"

Some people again might say Malachi is Old Testament, but Jesus tells us in the New Testament something similar.

Luke 6:38 says, "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into

your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

This is a trust issue. If we really believed in our heart that God will take care of us and honor our faith, He will. When we realize that He can do more with our 10 percent (and faith) than we can, then we trust Him, and He will open the floodgates of heaven on our behalf because of our faith and trust in Him.

The other thing I want to address here is **where** do we give.

Prior to Jesus coming, in the Old Testament, tithes were given to the priests so there was food in God's house. Well, things have changed in the New Testament. We now have Christ living on the inside of us. We are now kings and priests in God's kingdom as Revelation 1:6 says, "... and He has made us to be a kingdom of priests to His God and Father to Him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen."

This is a powerful statement from our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. I know we have been taught to give to a church, but my friend, the scripture just told us that we are priests of the kingdom of God. We are now the Church. Christ lives in us which means we are the priests Jesus was referring to in Revelation 1:6. WOW! This might be a revelation for some Christians.

So, who do I personally tithe to? Whoever or wherever God tells me to tithe. Yes, I often tithe to my church, but we as the body of believers are the church now. So, when God tells me to tithe to a church, an organization, or a person, I obey God, and I am blessed. If God has not given me direction, I give to where I am fed spiritually. This could be a TV pastor, or a Christ centered organization, or even a person/coach who spoke into my life.

7. Next, we use our words!

Yes, that is right. For us to live in the kingdom of God here on earth we MUST use our words to state the promises of God. When we state, "by His stripes I am healed" or God provides for me." It is our belief and faith in God's provision that gets us through our situation. We are workers together with God so there might be something else we are guided to do.

Sometimes, we know what to do.

Proverbs 18:21 tells us, "The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit." We are known by our fruit as Galatians 5 teaches us. When we use our words, we help to make our faith, our reality. In fact, the reality we find ourselves in right now is directly correlated to the words we have spoken, or words we believed about ourselves, perhaps our whole life. Words matter.

When we say, "I am sick." We make it a fact and we believe it. But if we were to say, "I am not feeling well, what can I do to feel better?" We are asking a question. Which we receive an answer. The answer can be anything from: rest, eat chicken soup, or repent for a sin. Whatever comes to our mind, is what we should do because our mind is connected to the mind of Christ. This is a very simplistic explanation, but the rule applies no matter what the situation.

One personal example is when I was asked to have my own TV show. I had been asked this several times before, but I did not feel right or motivated to do it at the time. I felt hesitant even though it sounded like a great idea. However, when I was told after my fourth TV interview, "You need to have your own show." I

heard God tell me, "It's time." I said to the Pastor and Reverend, "Okay, I'll do it." They both looked at me in amazement. I said, "God said, 'It's time.' So, I'll do it." This agreement with God by saying, "I'll do it." Opened up the doors and within six months, I had my own TV show. – Our Words Matter!

8. Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Some Christians don't want to talk about the gifts of the Holy Spirit but let's face it, if we ignore them, they don't go away. So, let's take a look at them in 1 Corinthians 12.

Verse one says, "Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware." So, what does this mean? Paul is telling the Corinthians that he wants them to have a good understanding of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and not be ignorant about them. We should know this applies to us as well.

We don't have time to take a deep dive into the gifts in this e-book, but I do support everyone in researching the scriptures for themselves and follow up with a class which teaches more about the manifestations of these gifts. The quick version is there are a variety of gifts, ministries, and effects, but the same Spirit of God works all things in all persons. The specific nine gifts of the Holy Spirit are:

- 1. Word of Wisdom
- 2. Word of Knowledge
- 3. Faith
- 4. Healing
- 5. Miracles
- 6. Prophecy
- 7. Speaking in Tongues
- 8. Interpretation of Tongues
- 9. Discernment of spirits

What I will say about all these gifts is they all have their place in the body of Christ, and so do we as the children of God. We are to be workers together and work in unity. We may not have the same gifts, but it is possible for God to work all the gifts within us if we are willing to allow Him access by our free will. I personally have operated every gift as the Lord guided me. Many Christians have also because they were aware that they were available and chose to allow God to work through them.

When we pray and ask God to lead us or give us a Word of Knowledge, or a Word of Wisdom

then, He will. This is how I operate the gifts. If I need an answer to something, or if I feel led to pray for someone for healing or miracles, God gives me direction on how to pray. Or I will speak in tongues for a person. I have seen many people healed and delivered from deaths door. He can deliver for you as well when you feel led to ask Him. You have to believe He hears you when you ask. You must believe He can heal or deliver. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. So, again, it is a good reason to read the scriptures, and acknowledge God when He speaks to you.

9. Faith

"And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him," Hebrews 11:6.

And James 2:14 tells us that faith without works is dead.

When we have faith in what God tells us, (keeping hope in our hearts), we are walking and talking exactly what He guides us to do, say, and pray. We do this because we have a relationship with our Jesus. We are hearkening

to His Words because we love Him. We do all this because we know the power of keeping in step with the Spirit of God.

We can read in Hebrew chapter 11 of all the men and women of faith, and how it was counted as righteousness to each of them. That is exactly how it works for us here and now.

10. Hope

"Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit," Romans 15:13 NKJV.

The hope that we have of heaven is meant to strengthen and encourage us. It is meant to fill us with wondrous joy through the Holy Spirit. When Jesus became our Savior, heaven became our ultimate destination. Because of our faith, we will not be separated from God. Hope keeps us spiritually alive during dark times of adversity. It brightens our path and heightens our awareness of the presence of God. Jesus' desire is that we may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. As we believe our prayers are being answered, this gives us hope, which is the opposite of worry.

Hebrews 6:19-20 NKJV says, "This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil, where the forerunner has entered for us, even Jesus, having become High Priest Forever according to the order of Melchizedek."

Many know, Melchizedek was king of Salem, as well as the priest of the Most-High God. This is who Abram gave 10 percent (tithe) of the spoil after rescuing Lot the first time. After Abram tithed, God came to him in a vision and made a covenant with him, stating his descendants would come from his body and would be more numerous than the stars. Abram **believed** God and it was accounted to him as **righteousness**.

His promised son was born when Abram turned 99 and Sarai was 90. God then gave him the name Abraham and Sarai the name Sarah. It was the hope of Abram which carried him through until his promised son was born. And it is the hope within us which carries us through until we too receive the promises God tells us individually.

And these, my friend, are the TOP ten keys to walking in the kingdom of God here on earth. If you noticed, I coupled a few of these keys together because they all work together, just like we as the body of Christ work together in unity. If someone is hurting, we are all hurting. If someone is celebrating, we celebrate together. If you would like to live in the kingdom of God here on earth, just follow these simple keys. Your life will change significantly. When you find the enemy is onto your new lifestyle, let him know you have authority in Christ, and he's a liar if he tries to convince you otherwise. Remember, YOUR words matter.
