

Soon Dad came in to check on their progress. "Wow guys. You must have been racing. How'd you get finished so quickly? Did you use the drill I told you not to use"? "We did Dad", Andy said, "but see what a great job we did, and we didn't even get hurt"! Dad looked at the floor, then at the kids. His eyes were filling with tears as he spoke. "I want to tell you both how good you did, but I let you use all my tools and the shop space, and you disobeyed the one rule I gave you. I'm sorry, but this will be the last time you are allowed in my workshop".
