

TREE REMOVAL PROCEDURES
(DEAD OR ALIVE)

Definition of a tree:

Any rooted growth (tree, shrub, evergreen, etc.) dead or alive that is larger than 4" in diameter at 5' above the ground

Per Queen Anne (QA) County Inspector; Gene Palmatary

- 1 If you have a tree that does **not** meet the definition of a tree in the box above:
 - submit a site plan to Beach Harbor (BH) for your request. Clearly tag the tree(s) you want removed.
 - The BH Covenants & Restrictions Chairperson will inspect your site per your request.
 - Your request will be approved or disapproved by BH. Should your request be disapproved, you will be provided with a reason.

2. If you have a tree that meets the definition of a tree in the box above, you will need to obtain a permit from the QA County Department of Permits (at a cost of \$45 per application) by following the below listed procedures:
 - Contact Mr. Gene Palmatary at the QA Co. Permit Department on 410-758-4088 between the hours of 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. Monday through Friday. He will come to your site to approve or disapprove your tree removal request within a few days. He will provide you with a verbal decision.
 - If Mr. Palmatary approves your request you can proceed with obtaining a permit from the QA Permit Department. The cost is \$45 per application.
 - After obtaining a QA County Permit, you must submit your site plan to BH with a copy of your permit attached for final BH approval.

BE REMOVED WITHOUT A BH APPROVED SITE PLAN!

Take Rt 301 North to Rt. 213 West
(Centreville).

Proceed on Rt. 213 to red light (Coursevail
Dr.) turn right.

Proceed to 160 Coursevail Dr. (2nd identical
building on the right.)

Enter center doors to the Permit Department
on the left hand side.
