The Public Hearing for the adoption of the FY 2023 – 2024 budget for the Cedar County Joint 911 Service Board was called to order at 8:15 am on Tuesday, February 7, 2023 by Sheriff Warren Wethington, 911 Service Board Chair. A roll call vote was taken. Those attending by teleconference included Amy Bishop, Clarence City Council Member; Michael Tharp, Stanwood City Council Member. Those attending in person included Joe Sparks, Mayor of Bennett; Steve Bixler, Mayor of Clarence; Jon Bell, Cedar County Board of Supervisors; Warren Wethington, Cedar County Sheriff; Jodi Freet, Director Cedar County EMA/911; Mindy Beekman, Office Coordinator Cedar County EMA; Sue Hall, Press. A quorum was established.

Supervisor Bell made a motion to approve the agenda; motion seconded by Mayor Sparks/Bennett. Motion carried.

Sheriff Wethington read the purpose of the public hearing: The 911 Service Board of Cedar County is conducting a public hearing on the proposed fiscal year 2023 – 2024 budget. At this public hearing, any resident or taxpayer may present objections to, or arguments in favor of, any part of the proposed budget. This notice represents a summary of the supporting detail of receipts and expenditures on file with the 911 Service Board Secretary. Copies of the supplemental budget detail will be furnished upon request.


Director Freet advised the Service Board that there were no objections on record.
