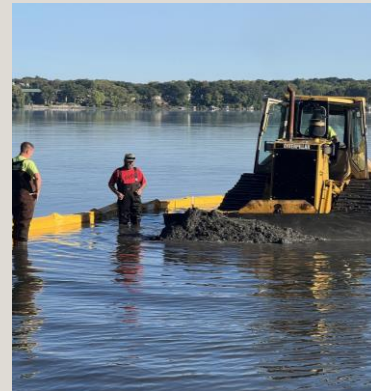
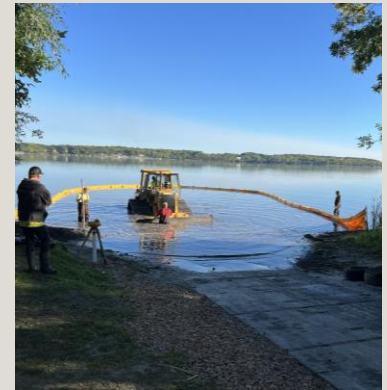

- SLA received \$3,332 from Spring Lake Township & City of Prior Lake for temporary repairs.
- Required Floating Silt Barrier Owned by SLA for future use.

# 2022 EURASIAN WATER MILFOIL (EWM)

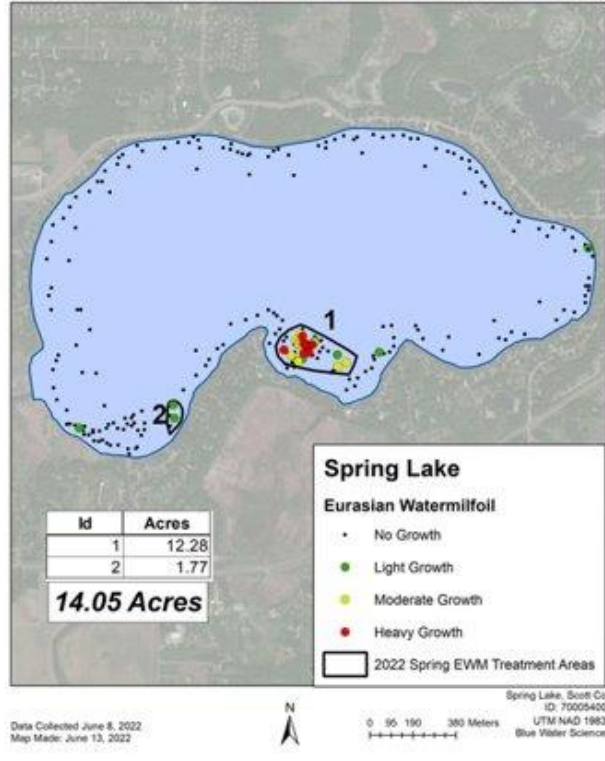

- Three surveys, 2 treatments completed at a cost of \$27,000.

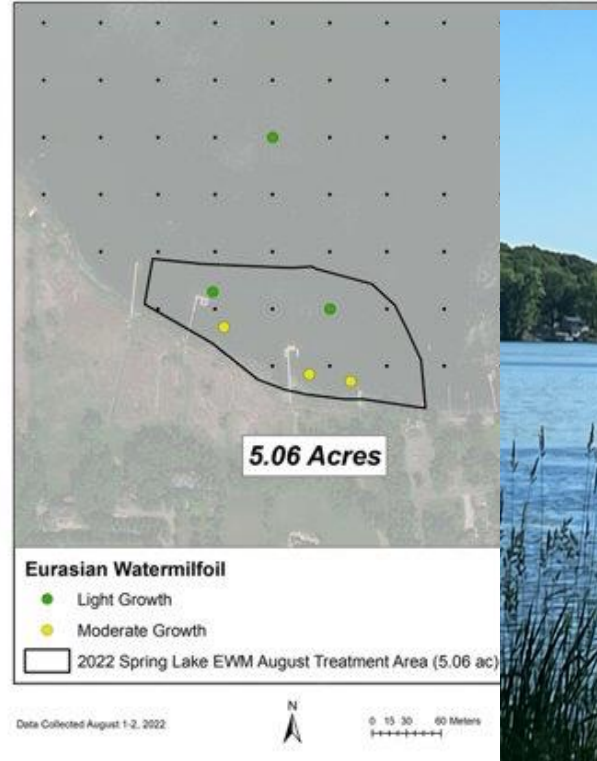

# 2023 EURASIAN WATER MILFOIL (EWM)

---

- Additional survey to be conducted early June 2023
- Assess treatment effectiveness from 2021 and 2022
- DNR Funds are available for additional survey and treatment if needed through June 2023



# ZEBRA MUSSELS FOUND ON SPRING LAKE

- Lone Zebra Mussel found lake survey April 2022
- Additional locations reported in June.
- None found in 2020 Charlie Malecha Boy Scout project
- SLA members placed Zebra Ladders throughout Lake
- Ladder inspections, heavy, moderate, light found through the lake.
- Difficult to manage / mitigate per DNR
- Follow Clean, Drain, Dispose policy



# KEEP IT CLEAN CAMPAIGN

---

- Started by Lake of the Woods 2012
- Picked up by Mille Lacs Area Community Foundation
- Focused on removal and disposal of garbage and human waste left on ice
- Campaign to provide consistent messaging for ice fisherman.
- Buckingham Companies sponsors garbage & recycle cans at the boat ramp year long and at the winter access January - April

**HELP KEEP SPRING LAKE CLEAN AND HEALTHY!**

**Make a Plan Before you Arrive** to dispose of your trash and human waste. If your access site doesn't provide trash and waste service, take it home and properly dispose of it.

**Use Colored Garbage Bags** they are easier to see in snowy conditions making it less likely trash and waste will be accidentally left behind.

**Keep your Garbage and Human Waste Off the Ice** store it in your fish house, vehicle or trailer. Make sure it's secure before traveling so that it doesn't blow out of ruck beds or off trailers and sleds.

**Upon Departure, Check for Trash** to make sure you haven't left anything behind.

**Allow Time and Bring the Tools You Need** to move or remove your fish house. Take all support blocks, insulation, landscaping fabric, wood and other materials with you and properly dispose of them.

# Carp Removals – Spring Lake 2022

- Changing carp behavior
  - In-lake spawning (not ideal)
    - Barriers are working!
  - No aggregations for seining
- Removed ~1,700 lbs of carp from Spring Lake
- Electrofishing & staff-led netting

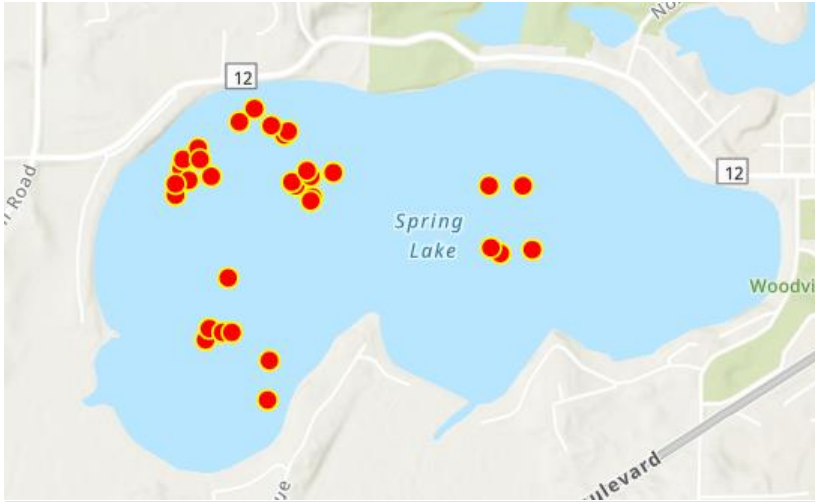


# Carp Removals – Spring Lake 2023

- Under ice seine on February 16<sup>th</sup>
  - ~ 11,500 pounds removed
- Healthy game fish population seen on seine day

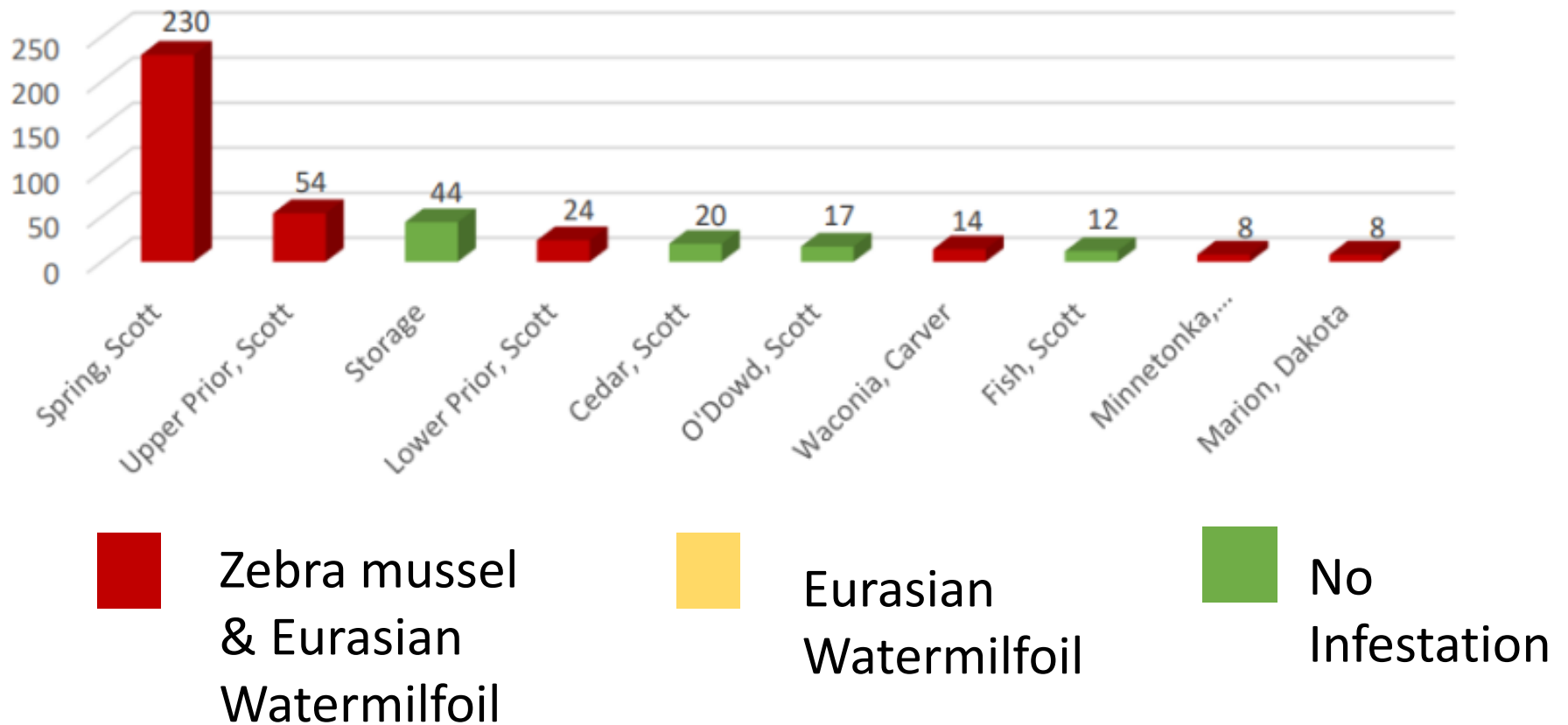
# Boat Inspections

  - Zebra mussels

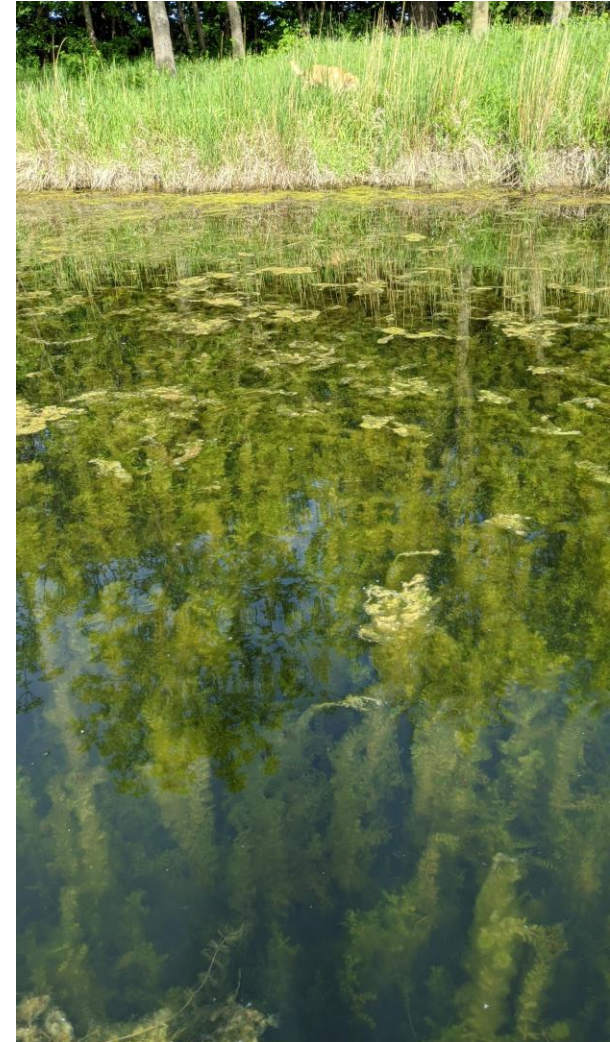

- Hosted training site to ID Starry Stonewort and other AIS plants/animals
- Search local lakes

# Iron Enhanced Sand Filters

- Goal: Improve water quality through phosphorus reduction
- IESFs bind with phosphorus and allow sediment to settle
- Potential projects & next steps:
  - Sutton Lake IESF
  - Spring West IESF
  - Feasibility studies complete
    - Assessing potential sites
    - Continuing landowner communications



# Wetland Enhancements

- Potential Goals: wetland enhancement, water quality improvement, increased storage capacity
- Spring West Wetland Enhancement
  - Two concepts: flood storage or create higher quality wetland for wetland credits
  - Next steps: landowner outreach
- Buck East Wetland Enhancement
  - Four concepts with varying goals
  - Next steps: finalize feasibility study
  - and continue landowner discussions

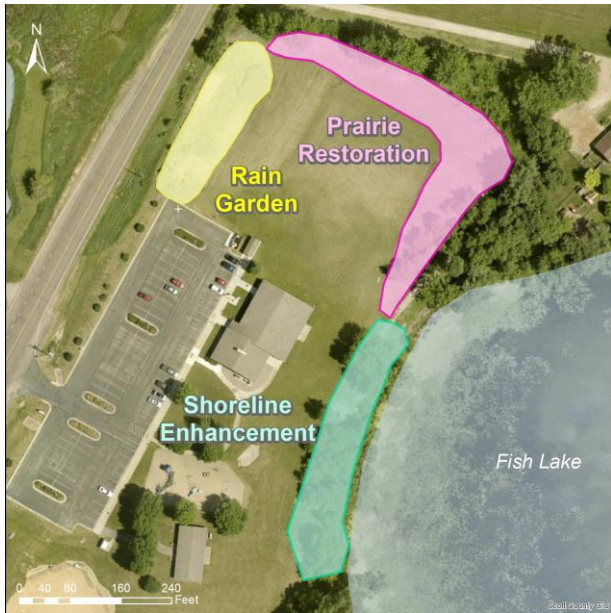


# Additional Priorities & Projects

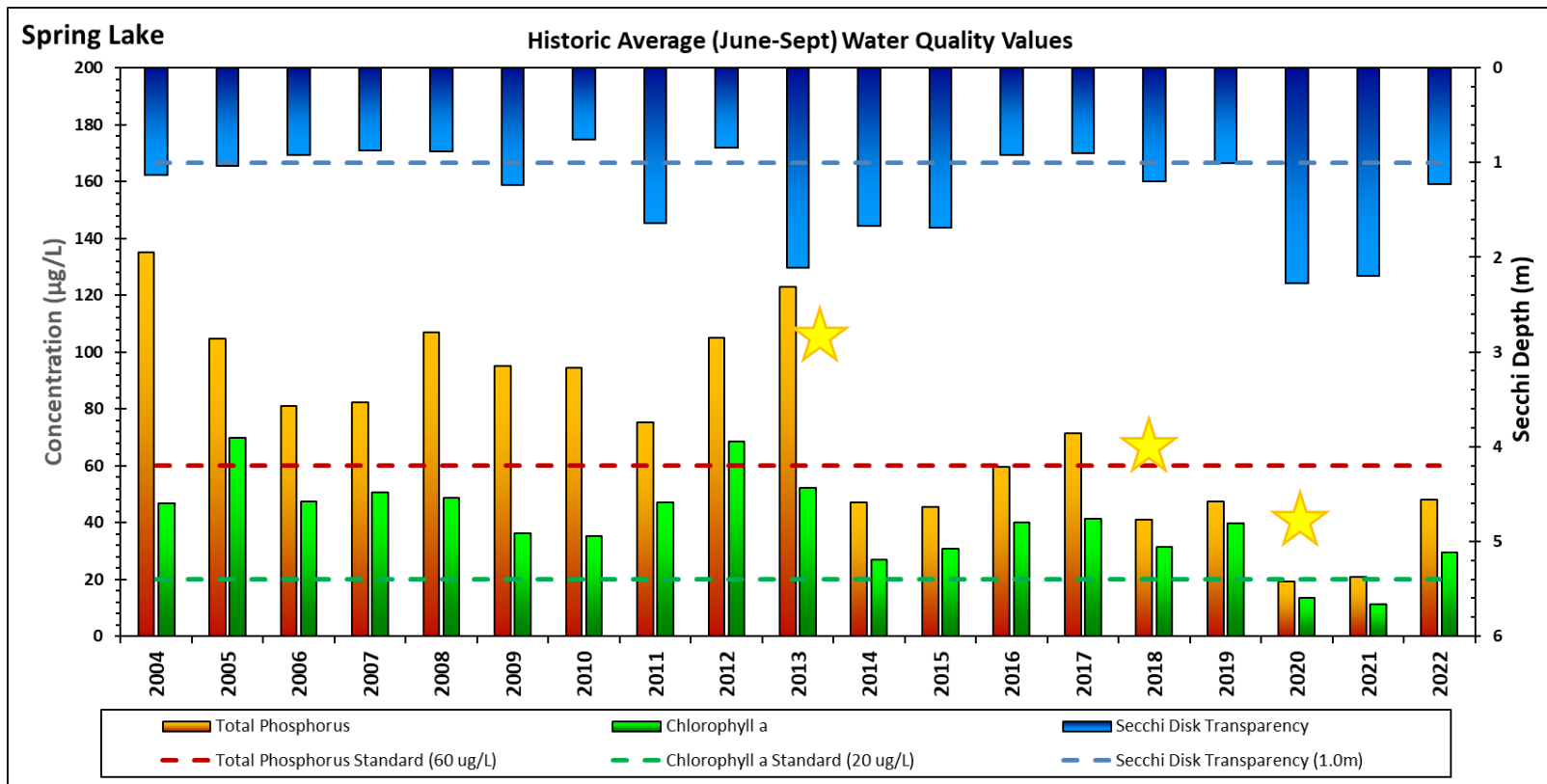

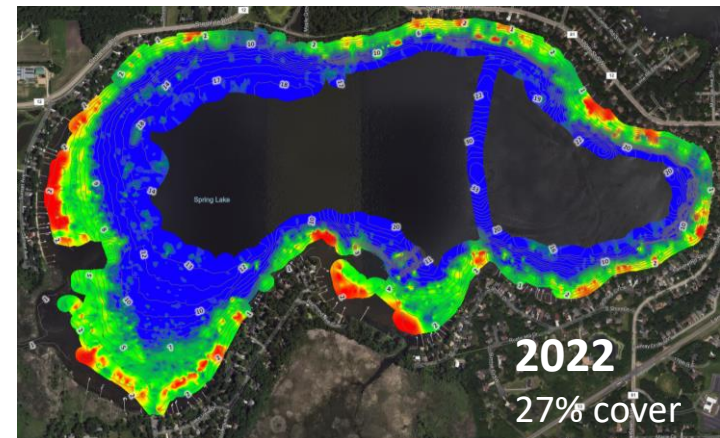
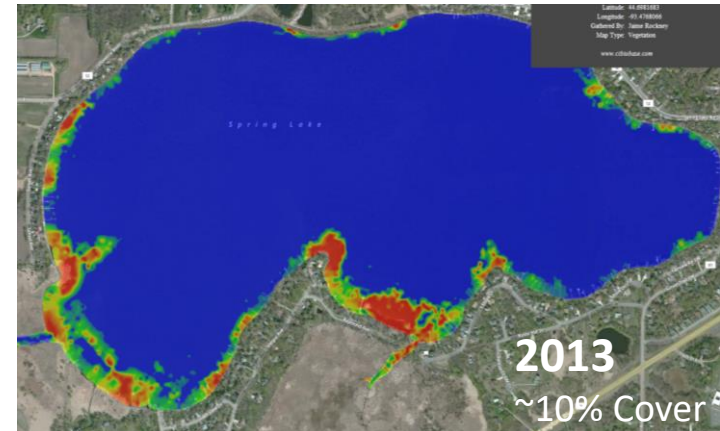

# Aquatic Plant Improvement on Spring Lake

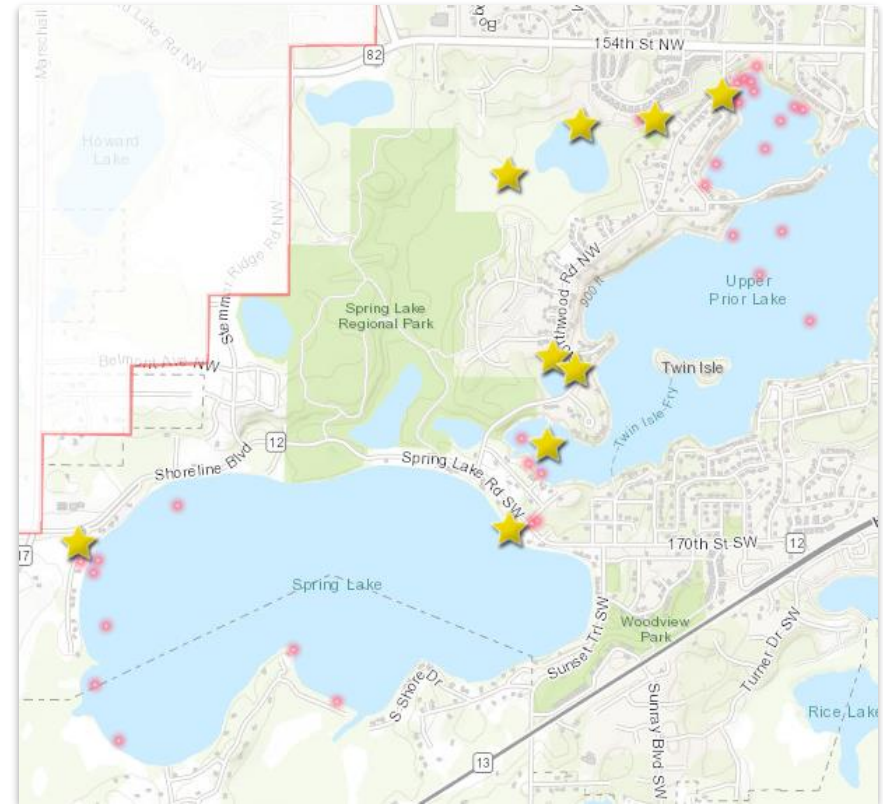
- Increased plant growth and diversity!

### President's Message From Wesley Steffan

As we proceed into 2023, many of us are focused on the current snowfall and wondering where our lake level will be this year after two years of drought. We are encouraged by the above average snowfall this winter and a forecasted wet spring which will hopefully bring our lake water back up to a more normal level.

### 2023 SLA Objectives |

1. Improve Lake Quality using the DNR Grant & member donations.
2. Increase Sponsor Involvement & Engagement.
3. Increase member engagement through education, social activities & communication.

**Lake Improvement |** This will be the second year of the \$50,000 DNR grant that the SLA was awarded in 2022 to manage and control the spread of Eurasian Water Milfoil.

- In 2022, \$27,000 was used to treat 20 acres.
- In 2023, we will conduct a survey in late April and early June to assess the success of the treatment and to determine the next steps treatments in 2023.
- We will continue to work with the DNR and state leaders on boat ramp improvement.

**Sponsors |** Our Sponsors play a critical role in providing a good portion of our funding. Gold and Silver sponsors are listed to the left and Gold Sponsor Ads are sprinkled throughout the newsletter. We hope that you will support our sponsors when you need their services.

**Member Engagement |** Education efforts this year will focus on creating awareness around Safety and Boating Etiquette. Based on the well-attended Aquatic Seminar that was held last year, plans are to have another seminar hosted by Steve McCommas from Blue Water Science in July.

Lastly we are excited that work on the Spring Lake Park on the north side of the Lake will begin this year. Patricia Freeman provided an update on the project in this newsletter.

  - Currently Required for youths age 12 – 17 years
  - Bills being considered in House and Senate
    - Would require anyone born after 1987



# BOATING ETIQUETTE RECOMMENDATIONS

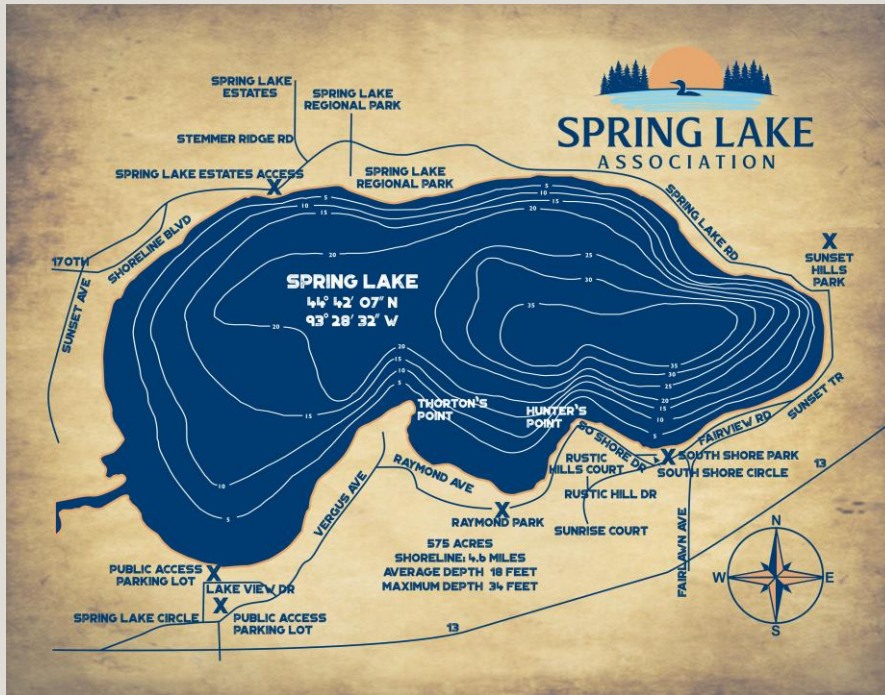
---

- **Dispose of your trash properly.**
- **Respect the ramp.** Don't power load your boat!
- **Own your wake.** During Wake related activities, maintain a SAFE distance way from other boaters sharing the water, boat in the center of the lake away from shore,, depth >15 ft
- **Rules of the road.** Know navigation rules and the Right of Way basics for boating.
- **Be prepared.** Know state & local laws life jackets requirement for each person onboard.
- **Be polite – give a wave.**

## Need to Know Information

**SPRING LAKE ASSOCIATION**

**MINNESOTA PERSONAL WATERCRAFT LAWS**

**YOU MUST....**

- Wear a USCG-approved life jacket. Comply with label.
- Travel at slow-no-wake speed (5 mph or less) within 150 feet of: non-motorized boats; shore (unless launching or landing skiers directly to or from open water); docks; swim rafts; swimmers; or any moored or anchored boat.
- Operate only from 9:30 a.m. to one hour before sunset.
- Use the cutoff lanyard properly.
- Obey operator age and permit laws for those younger than 18 years old.

**YOU MUST NOT....**

- Chase or harass wildlife.
- Jump the wake of another boat within 150 feet of the craft.
- Operate a personal watercraft in a manner that endangers life, limb or property.
- Protect Your Sport Respect your neighbors.
- Don't operate for long periods in the same area or near occupied boats or shore.

Decals which contain the above are available from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources. This is only a summary of the laws as of June 2018 and is required to be visible to the operator on all personal watercraft in Minnesota.

**TOP 5 BOATING SAFETY TIPS**

1. Wear your life jacket and make sure children wear theirs - LIFE JACKETS SAVE LIVES
2. Stay sober - Booze and boating don't mix. Alcohol is the #1 factor in boating fatalities.
3. Tell a friend - Tell someone where you are going and when you will be back. If you're not back, they should call 911. Bring a phone or VHF radio.
4. Be weather aware - Don't let a storm sneak up on you - delay your trip or head to shore. Go slow in rough water to avoid capsizing.
5. Boat smart - Take a boat safety course. Know your boat; stay alert while scanning for dangers; stay seated and low in the boat to prevent falls overboard.

**SUMMARY OF SPRING LAKE USE RESTRICTIONS PRIOR LAKE, CITY OF / SPRING LAKE TOWNSHIP**

1. Slow-no wake zone on entire lake when water level exceeds 912.8 feet.
2. Slow-no wake zone within 150 feet of shore and specified channels.
3. 40 mph - daytime speed limit weekends and holidays (Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day Weekend).
4. 20 mph nighttime speed limit all year.
5. No inflatable devices (air mattresses, inner tubes) beyond 150 feet of shore.
6. Swimming must be within 150 feet of shore, unless accompanied by watercraft.
7. No water skiing or towed tubes within 150 feet of shore - except for launching or landing directly to and from shore.

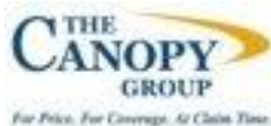
