Nutcracker will be at the Lyric Theatre Friday, December 15<sup>th</sup> thru Sunday, December 17<sup>th</sup>. We will perform 4 performances open to the public. Friday evening as well as Saturday Matinée and Evening and Sunday performance. Rehearsals will be Fridays thru Sunday. Most rehearsals will be held on Saturday. Nutcracker performances will be a commitment from September thru December 17<sup>th</sup>. We have no scheduled rehearsals the week of Thanksgiving. If you tell us in advance, we can work around any other conflicts that may come up. Nutcracker will have a one-time fee of \$225 dollars that is nonrefundable. We will be having a lead role audition \*Saturday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, it will be open to ballet 4 and above. Nutcracker audition forms and commitment details will be available once class registration is received. \*Audition date subject to change.



Preballet: pink tights, pink leotard, pink ballet shoes (full soul leather), skirts are allowed if all ready attached to leotard, hair in a bun.

**Ballet students**: black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes (dancers may switch to split souls or canvas shoes once they are on point), hair in a bun.

Jazz, modern, and contemporary students: black leggings, solid colored leotard or tight fitting tank top, bare foot (if uncomfortable dancing bare foot you may wear black socks), jazz shoes required (jazz students only) hair must be pulled back away from their face.

*<u>Hip hop students</u>*: black bottoms, solid color t-shirts, hip-hop sneakers or shoes designated for dance class (not worn on the street)
