FAITH LESSON 11 of 14

Matthew 6:19-21 NLT

"The point is, don't store up treasures here on earth, where they can be eaten by **moths**, and get rusty, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your **treasures** in heaven, where they will never become moth-eaten, or rusty, and where they will be safe from thieves. Wherever your treasure is, there your heart and thoughts will also be."

1 Peter 4:19 NLT

"So if you are suffering in a manner that PLEASES God, keep on **doing** what is right, and trust your lives to the God who created you, for He will never, NEVER fail you."

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 ESV
