SEE Matthew 7:28 "When Jesus finished speaking, they were AMAZED at His teaching, for He taught as One Who had real authority....."

Amazed and Astonished





Exodus 32:19 NLT

"When they came near the camp, Moses saw the **calf** and the dancing, and he burned with terrible anger. He threw the stone tablets to the **ground**, smashing them at the foot of the mountain."

Mark 1:21-22 NKJV

"Then they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath, He [Jesus] entered the synagogue and taught. And they were astonished at His teaching, for He taught them as one having **authority**, [Gk: didache • "did'-a-kay"] and not like their scribes."

Mark 11:18 VOICE / BRG

(After turning over the money-changers' tables – "you have made this Temple a den of thieves.") "The chief priests and the scribes heard these words and knew Jesus was referring to them, so they plotted His **destruction**. They had grown afraid of Him because all of the people were astonished at His **doctrine**, by His teaching."

Luke 4:32 NKJV / VOICE

(After attempts in **Nazareth** to throw Jesus over the cliff, He went down to Capernaum and taught in the synagogue there.) "And they were astonished at His **Words**. He had a way of saying things—a special authority, a unique power."

Acts 13:12 NOG

(After **Paul**, thru the Holy Spirit, blinded the false prophet / sorcerer) "Then the proconsul believed, when he saw what had been done, being astonished at the **teaching** of the Lord."

Exodus 20:1-17 NLT

"Then God instructed the people as follows:

- 1) You shall have no other gods before Me. [God should be number one.]
- 2) You shall not make yourself any graven (engraved, sculptured) image. [Don't bow down to anything but God.]
- **3) You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.** [Don't use your lips to dishonor God.]
- 4) Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it holy. [Do not neglect the things of God.]
- 5) Honor your father and mother.
- 6) You shall not murder.
- 7) You shall not commit adultery. [Adultery leaves a broken heart.]
- 8) You shall not steal.
- 9) You shall not lie (bear false witness). [a "lying" nine]

10) You shall not covet. [Don't want what others have.] "A person MUST continue to follow only the teaching of Christ. If he goes beyond Christ's teaching, then he does NOT have God.
