

How satan uses guilt to trap you





Colossians 1:22 NLT

"Yet now He [God] has **reconciled** you to Himself through the death of Christ in His physical body. As a result, He has brought you into His own presence, and you are holy and **blameless** as you stand before Him without a single fault."

SEVERAL WORDS IN GREEK FOR RECONCILIATION

"diallasso" – 2 people at odds, need to be reconciled

from Matthew 5:23-24 NLT

"...if you suddenly **remember** that someone has something against you, **leave** your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. **Then** come and offer your sacrifice to God."

"apokatallasso" – 1 person has enmity in his heart, and needs to have barriers separating fellowship removed, but the other party has NO enmity

from 2 Corinthians 5:19, 21 VOICE

"....God was in [Christ], making things **right** between Himself and the world. This means He does NOT hold their sins against them....He actually orchestrated this: the Chosen One, who had never experienced sin, became sin for us so that **IN HIM** we might embody the very righteousness of God."

THE SIN SYNDROME

"We knowingly sin, we develop guilt, guilt leads to estrangement."

2 strategies to cope:

A person senses they've offended God, so try to **JUSTIFY THEMSELVES OR** person **CONDEMNS THEMSELVES** because God couldn't forgive.

3 TYPES OF GUILT IN THE LIFE OF A BELIEVER IN CHRIST

Legal Guilt –

1 John 1:8 AMP

"If we say we have no sin [refusing to admit that we are sinners], we **delude** ourselves and the truth is not in us. [His Word does not live in our hearts.]"

- The Unresolved Emotion of Guilt -

Romans 8:7 NCV

"When people's **thinking** is controlled by the sinful self, they are against God, because they refuse to obey God's law and really are not even able to obey God's law."

- Sorrowful Guilt that Leads to Repentance -

2 Corinthians 7:8-9a NLT

"I am not sorry that I sent that severe letter to you, though I was sorry at first, for I know it was **painful** to you for a little while. Now I am glad I sent it, not because it hurt you, but because the pain **caused** you to repent and change your ways. It was the kind of sorrow God wants his people to have..."

1 John 1:9 NASB [with a literal translation of the Greek tenses]

"If we keep on confessing our sins, He is faithful and righteous, to **have forgiven** us our sins and to **have cleansed** us from all unrighteousness."
