Psalm 86:15 GNT

“But you, O Lord, are a merciful and loving God, **always** patient, **always** kind and faithful.”

Psalm 145:8-9 BRG

“The Lord is gracious, and full of **compassion**; slow to anger, and of great mercy. The Lord is good to all: and His **tender** mercies are over all His works.”

Lamentations 3:22-23 ESV

“The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies **never** come to an end; they are **new** every morning; **great** is Your faithfulness!”

Micah 7:18-19 ICB

“There is no God like you. You forgive people who are **guilty** of sin. You don't look at the sins of Your people who are left alive. You, Lord, will **not** stay angry forever. You **enjoy** being kind. Lord, You will have mercy on us again. You will conquer our sins. You will throw away all our **sins** into the deepest sea.”

“Among these [unbelievers] we all once lived in the passions of our flesh [our behavior governed by the sinful self], **indulging** the desires of human nature [without the Holy Spirit] and [the impulses] of the [sinful] mind. We were, by nature, children [under the sentence] of [God's] **wrath**, just like the rest [of mankind]. But God, being [so very] rich in **mercy**, because of His great and wonderful love with which He loved us, even when we were [spiritually] dead and **separated** from Him because of our sins, He made us [spiritually] alive together with Christ [for by His grace—His **undeserved** favor and mercy—you have been saved from God's judgment.]”
