Hebrews 1:2-3 NLT

“And now in these final days, He (God) has spoken to us through His Son. God promised everything to the Son as an inheritance, and *through the Son* He **created** the universe. The Son radiates God’s own glory and expresses **1** the very character of God, and He sustains everything by the mighty power of His command. When He had **cleansed** us from our sins, He sat down in the place of honor at the right hand of the majestic God in heaven.”

Noah lifted back the **4** covering of the boat and saw that the surface of the ground was drying. **Two more months** went by, and at last the earth was dry! Then God said to Noah, ‘Leave the boat, all of you—you and your wife, and your sons and their wives. Release all the animals....’”

Revelation 8:8-11 NLT

“Then the second angel blew his trumpet, and a great mountain of **fire** was thrown into the sea. One-third of the water in the sea became blood, one-third of all things living in the sea died, and one-third of all the ships on the sea were destroyed. Then the third angel blew his trumpet, and a great **star** fell from the sky, burning like a **torch**. It fell on one-third **5** of the rivers and on the springs of water. The name of the star was Bitterness. It made one-third of the water bitter, and many people died from drinking the bitter water.”
