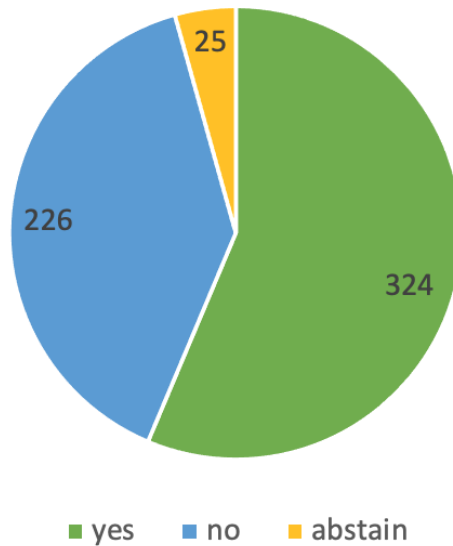

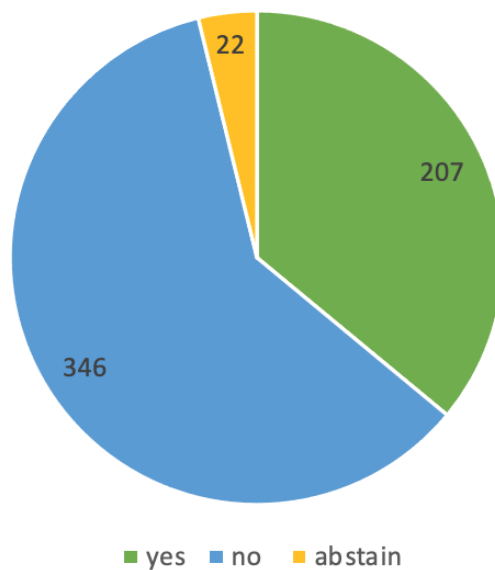
Executive Councillors (2 councillors) : \$3,000.00 each

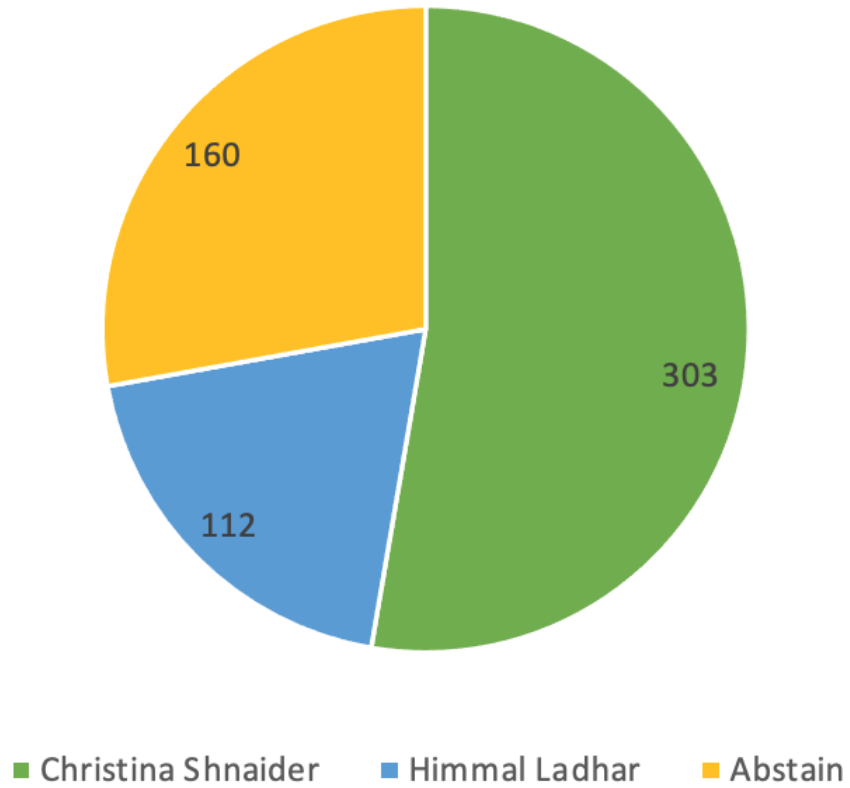

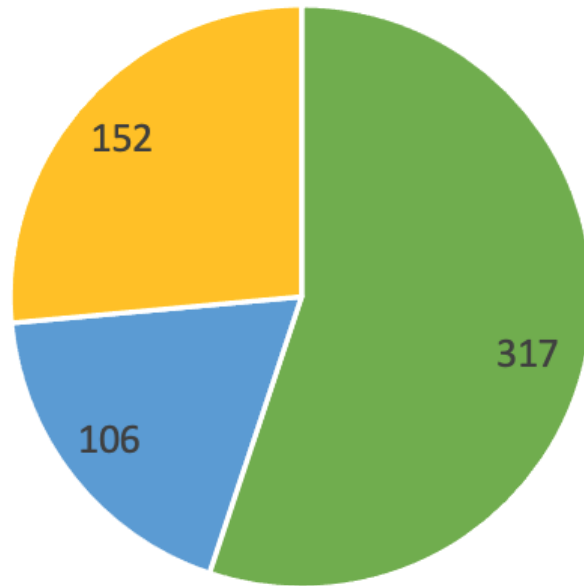

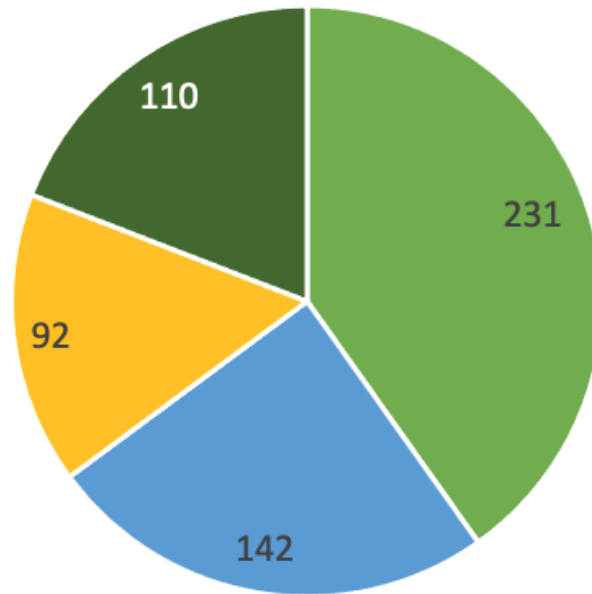

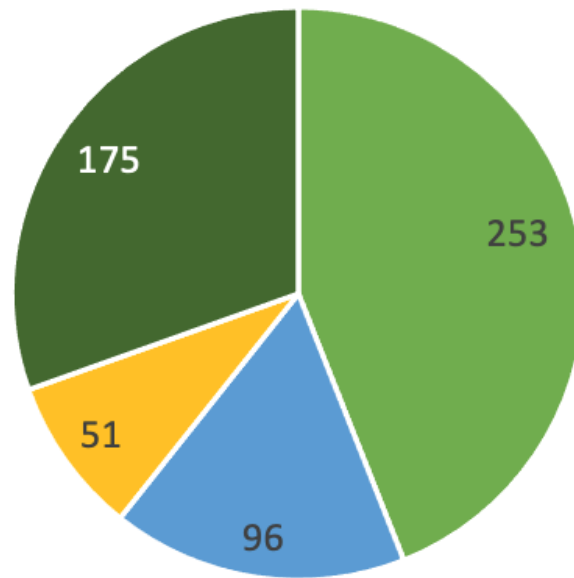

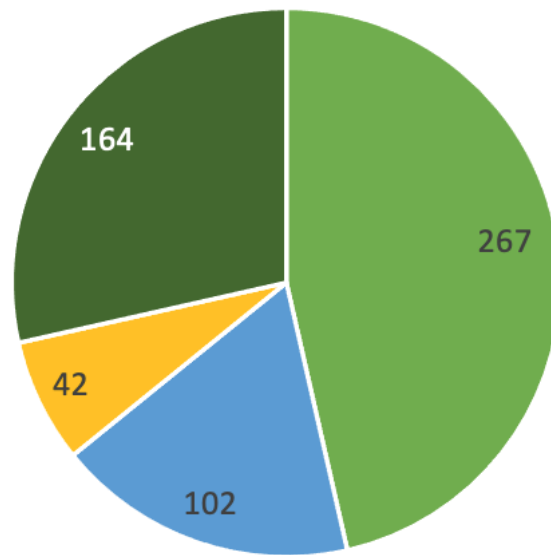

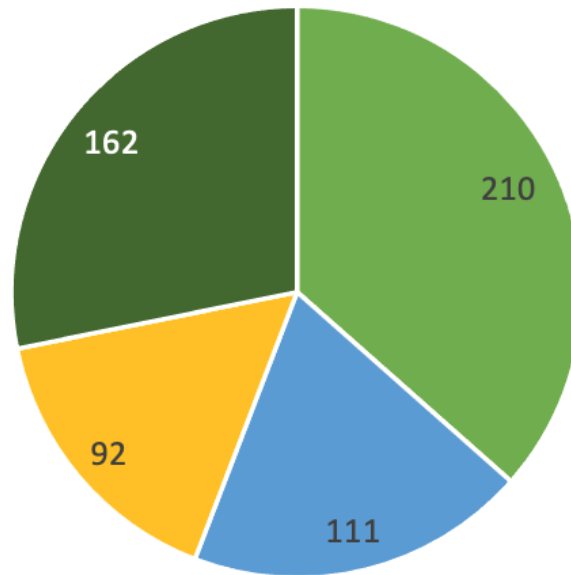

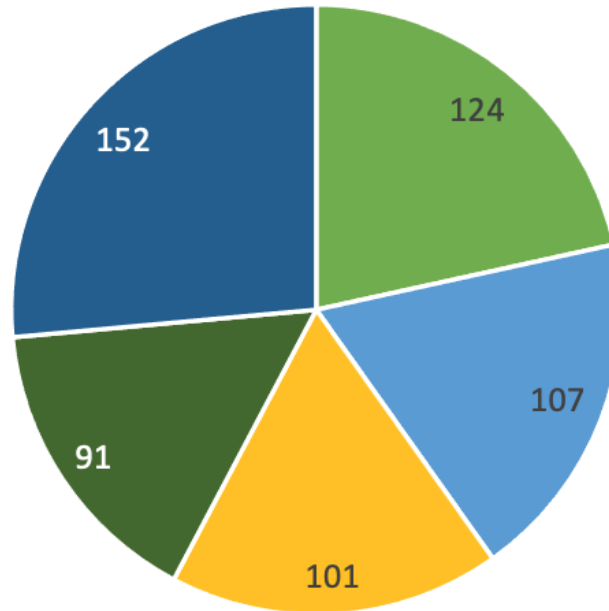

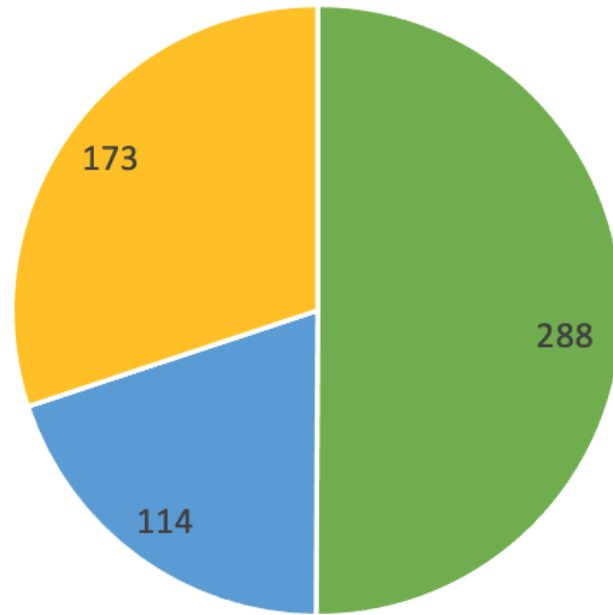
