Crock Pot Potato Soup

- 1 bag of frozen hash browns
- 1/2 Cup chopped onion
- 24 OZ chicken broth
- 1/3 TSP pepper
- 1 Can cream of chicken soup
- 8 OZ cream cheese

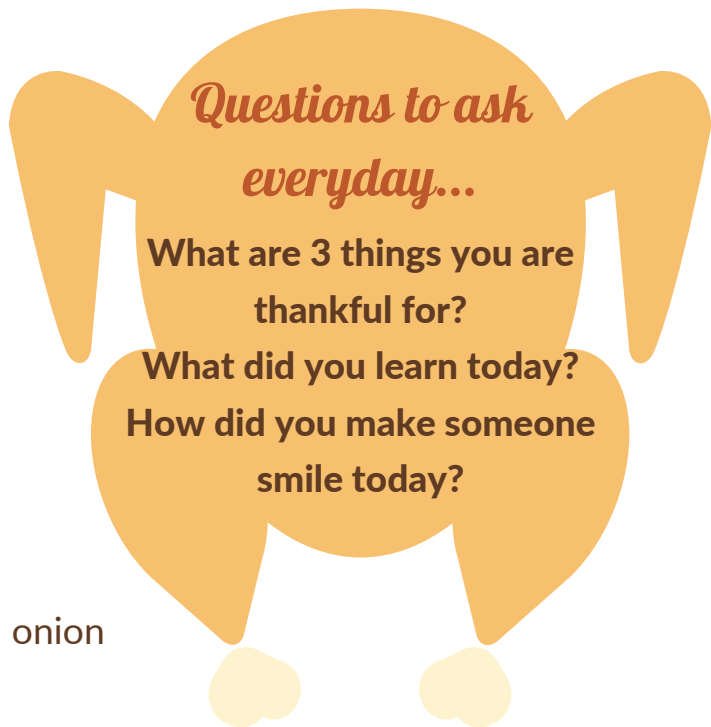
Place the frozen hash browns, chicken broth, cream of chicken soup, chopped onions, and ground black pepper in a crockpot. Cover the pot and turn the heat on low. Cook for 5 hours. Add 8 oz of softened cream cheese. Cook for an additional 30 minutes and stir now and then until combined. Optional but highly suggested: top with shredded Cheddar cheese, bacon strips, and minced green onion.

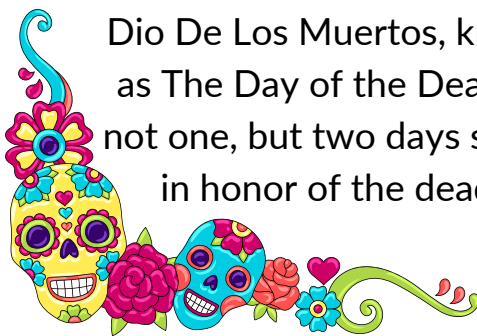

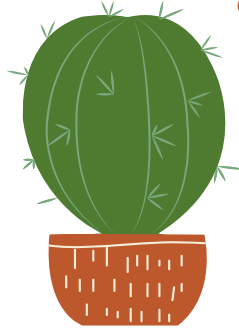
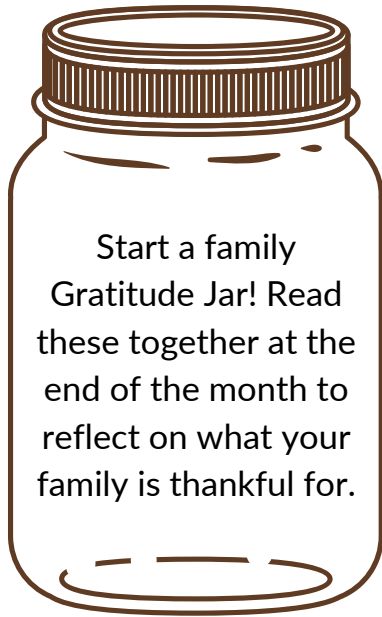
Dio De Los Muertos, known as The Day of the Dead, is not one, but two days spent in honor of the dead.

What is Veterans Day?

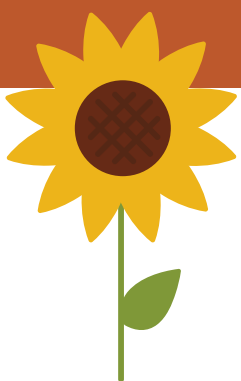
Veterans Day pays tribute to all American veterans—living or dead—but especially gives thanks to living veterans who served their country honorably during war or peacetime.
