

- The Gospel of Mark was written by John Mark c. A.D. 55–62.
- The Gospel of Luke was written by the physician Luke c. A.D. 55–62.
- The Gospel of John was written by the Apostle John c. A.D. 85.
- The book of Acts was written by Luke c. A.D. 62.
- The books of Romans through Philemon were written by the Apostle Paul from c. A.D. 50 to 68 (but not in the order in which they appear in the Bible).
- The Letter to the Hebrews is of uncertain authorship (possibly Paul) and was written around A.D. 67.
- The Letter of James was written by James, the Lord's brother, c. A.D. 48.
- Peter's two letters were written by the Apostle Peter c. A.D. 66.
- John's first, second, and third letters were written by John by about A.D. 90.
- The letter to Jude was written by Jude, the Lord's brother, c. A.D. 67.
- The book of Revelation was written by John around A.D. 90-95. (Some date it A.D. 69 or A.D. 85.)




