Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to London today.

London \rightarrow 3 nights

Day 2: Arrival in London

Included meals: welcome dinner
Welcome to England! Meet your Tour Director
and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of London

Included meals: breakfast
View the regal landmarks of England's vibrant
and cosmopolitan capital on a guided
sightseeing tour.

- Pass the grand Trafalgar Square and Baroquestyle St. Paul's Cathedral, perched atop Ludgate Hill
- See Westminster Abbey, the setting for royal coronations, weddings, and funerals
- View icons like Big Ben, the London Eye,
 Tower Bridge, and the Tower of London
- Stop by Buckingham Palace, where you may catch the Changing of the Guard

Enjoy a free afternoon in London or add an excursion.

Day 4: Sissinghurst Castle Garden & Hever Castle

Included meals: breakfast

Travel outside of London to visit Sissinghurst Castle, one of the world's most famous 20th-century castles.

- Take time to explore the castle's expansive gardens, which were created by Vita Sackville-West and Harold Nicholson
- Enjoy lunch at the castle during your free time

Then, continue on to Hever Castle & Gardens, the former home of Anne Boleyn.

 Explore the castle, viewing its unique double moat and splendid collection of antiques, furniture, and tapestries Tour the impressive gardens with a member of the Hever Castle gardening team, learning about century-old grounds which display William Waldorf Astor's collection of Italian statuary

Please note: Due to the narrow paths at Sissinghurst Castle, it is not possible to conduct formal guided tours around the garden. Discussions on the garden's history must be held outside the garden areas.

Bath \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 5: Bath via Windsor Castle

Included meals: breakfast, lunch
This morning, travel to Windsor for a guided tour
of the world's largest and longest-inhabited
castle, led by a Blue Badge Guide.

- Step inside the State Apartments and St.
 George's Chapel, where the Knights of the Garter ceremony takes place
- View the exhibit of royal treasures on display within the castle
- Stroll through the town of Windsor and have a look at Eton College, a prestigious prep school attended by Princes William and Harry
- Enjoy an included lunch with your group

Afterwards, travel to the town of Bath, famous for their Roman baths, charming restaurants, and perfect picnic spots. Enjoy free time for the rest of the day to explore at your leisure.

Please note: Windsor Castle is occasionally closed when in use by the Royal Family; a visit to Henry VIII's Hampton Court will be substituted if necessary.

Day 6: Sightseeing tour of Cotswolds

Included meals: breakfast, lunch
Set out to explore the villages, towns, and
landscapes throughout the rural Cotswolds
region today.

- Wander the lush english gardens of Tetbury and rococo gardens of Painswick
- Stop in the market town of Chipping Campden for free time to explore
- Sit down with your group for an included lunch in the Cotswolds

 Visit the Hidcote Manor Garden, called one of the top gardens in England, and explore the grounds at your own pace

Plymouth Region → 2 nights

Day 7: Transfer to Plymouth Region & Eden Project

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Make your way south to the coastal Plymouth
Region where you'll visit the Eden Project, two
enclosed biomes that replicate the weather and
vegetaion found in the rainforest and along the
mediterranean.

Tonight, sit down for an included dinner with your group.

Day 8: Sightseeing tour of the Cornwall Gardens

Included meals: breakfast

Spend the day traveling through the Cornwall region to visit some of the Great Gardens of Cornwall, a series of stunning gardens home to some of the most rare and beautiful plants in the British Isles.

- Begin with a visit to the Glendurgan Garden, a National Trust subtropical garden featuring an impressive laurel maze
- Spend time wandering the little paradise within the Trebah Garden where you'll find beautiful blooms, tunnels of color, a valley of hydrangeas, ponds, and more
- Discover the Lost Gardens of Heligan, a mysterious garden with playful sculptures, banana plantations, giant rhubarb all of which has been restored to create a truly special atmosphere

London \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 9: London via Stourhead House & gardens

Included meals: breakfast

As you travel back to London, pay a visit to Stourhead House and be transported to the world of Jane Austen's Pride and Prejudice as you walk through some of the films iconic locations. Spend time exploring the Palladian style house and grounds set on over 2,000 acres of extensive parklands and picture-perfect gardens.

Continue to London and enjoy a free evening or add an excursion.

Day 10: Chelsea Flower Show

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner
Spend the day at the Chelsea Flower Show,
attended by visitors from around the world. Your
Tour Director will guide you through the Royal
Horticultural Society's flagship annual event.

- See the best of garden design and horticultural trends at the Great Pavilion
- Get ideas to take home to your own gardens as you explore
- Watch as plant breeders unveil new plants Tonight, join your group to celebrate your trip during a farewell dinner.

Day 3: Kensington Palace & Afternoon Tea

\$145/\$155* (4.5 hours, departs late morning)

Nestled in Kensington Gardens on the corner of Hyde

Park, Kensington Palace has served as the London
residence for members of the Royal Family for hundreds
of years. Explore the palace's elaborate State

Apartments before making your way to the adjacent

Orangery for a traditional afternoon tea, served with
finger sandwiches, scones, and Cornish clotted cream.

Day 9: Thames River Cruise & Pub Dinner

\$125 (5 hours, departs in the afternoon, dinner included)

Step aboard a riverboat for a cruise down the Thames and take in views of the London skyline, Tower Bridge, Southbank, and more from the water. As you travel from Tower Pier to Westminster Pier, you'll snap photos of Shakespeare's Globe, the National Theatre, and Jubilee Gardens before disembarking and taking a tour through the Covent Garden area of the West End. Then, sit down for a three-course dinner including beer or wine at a local pub. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.
