Event Location: City Hall Breezeway: 3900 Main street, Riverside, California 92522

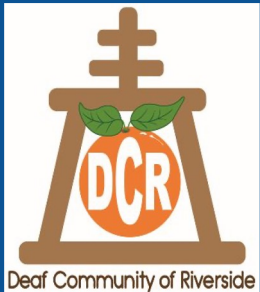
Event Set-up Time: Set-up will begin at 7:30 a.m. and continue until 9:30 a.m.

What will we provide? If weather cooperates, We will provide water bottles to each vendors, performers, Sponsors, and volunteers. Electricity will be available..(upon request)





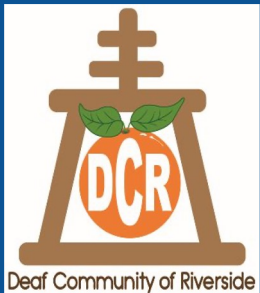

Event MAP:

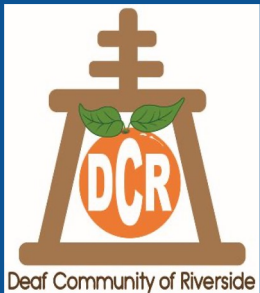
City Hall Breezeway
