

2015-2023 Routine Trapping Trends

- **32,025** Trap Nights
- 4 types of traps
 - Gravid
 - CDC
 - BG Sentinel
 - BG Pro
- 1,318,660 Total Mosquitoes collected

Count of Mosquitoes Collected in Routine Trapping (2015-2023)







Why Aedes aegypt?

- Before 2015, 1 *Ae. aegypti* collected in 2007, and multiple unconfirmed collections in 2003.
- Since 2015, 68 Ae. aegypti collected in routine trapping.*(One was a male)
- 17 locations have only had 1 Ae. aegypti collected (7 of those were new in 2023)
- Ae. aegypti collected at 40% (30) of routine trap locations since 2015
- **55%** of *Ae. aegypti* were collected with BG Sentinel Traps








Many Public Transportation Routes Between Fairfax and DC




Selected Fairfax Connector Bus Routes







Metro Rail Routes
