ESPP Endangered Species Protection Program 1988

To meet obligations under ESA

*Voluntary program that provided geographically specific pesticide use limitations in areas of concern

2005 ESPP became enforceable program

*Numerous Lawsuits against EPA for failing to meet its obligations under ESA.

*In 2022, EPA released its ESA Workplan:

*Prioritize FIFRA actions for ESA Compliance;

*Early Mitigation; and

*More efficient approaches

Intersect of ESA and FIFRA (Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act)

*Requires that federal agencies (US Fish & Wildlife Service and US Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration) communicate to ensure the actions they authorize are not going to impact the existence of any listed species.

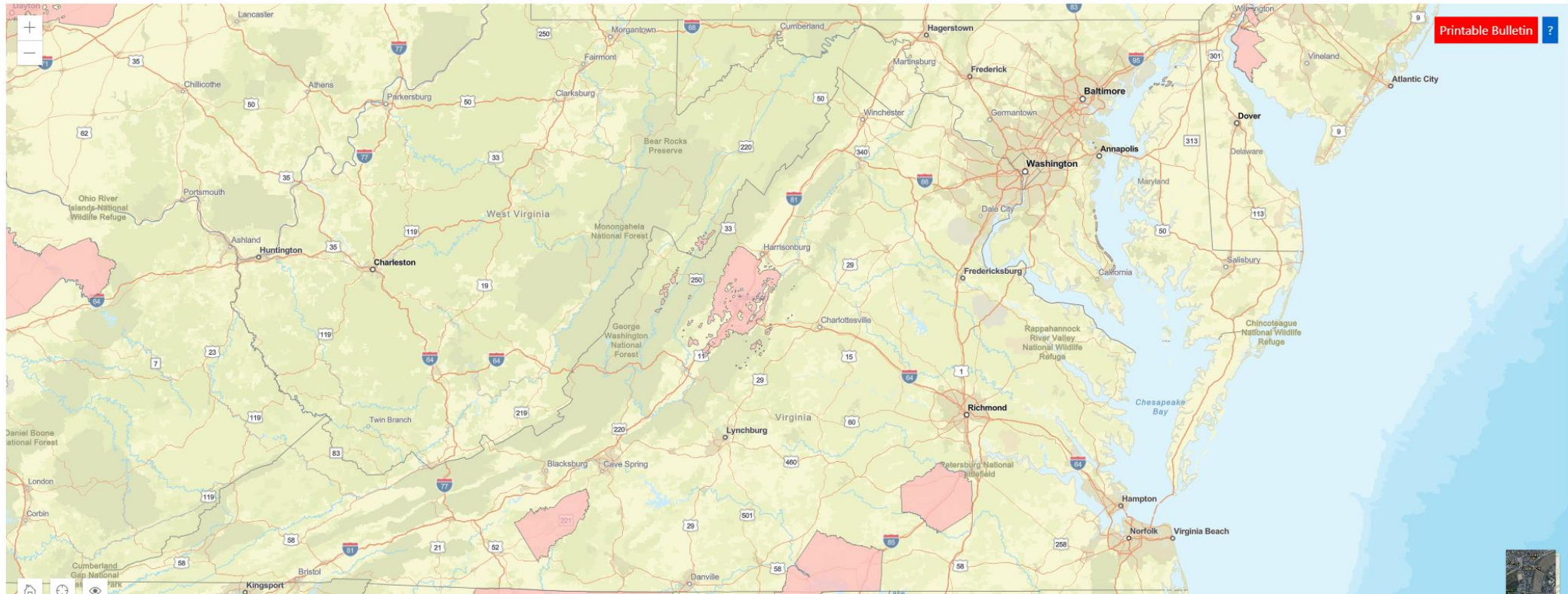
* "Actions" for EPA are all pesticide registration decisions (new or registration review)



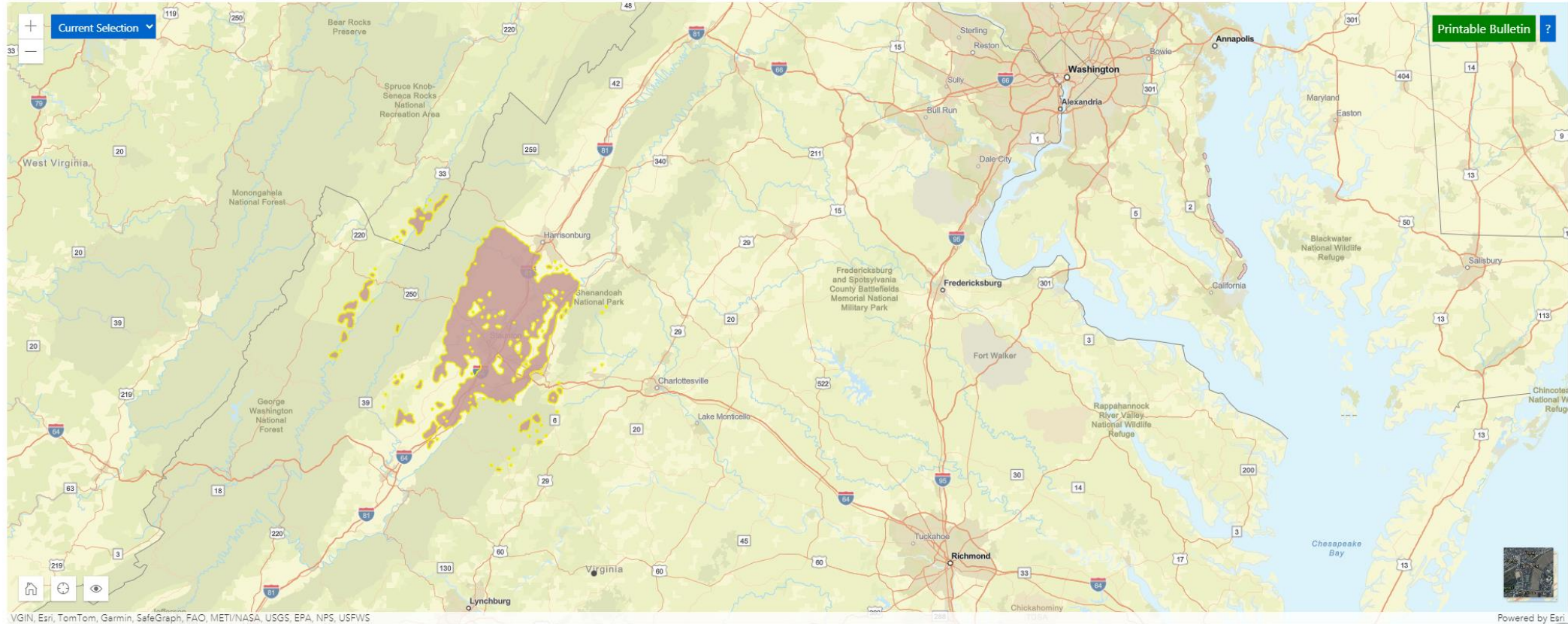

Bulletins Live! Two (BLT): Tutorial

[Bulletins Live! Two \(BLT\)](#) is the web-based application to access Endangered Species Protection Bulletins (Bulletins). These Bulletins contain enforceable pesticide use limitations that are necessary to ensure a pesticide's use will not harm a species listed as threatened or endangered (listed) under the Endangered Species Act or their designated critical habitat.

This tutorial explains the steps to use the BLT application, including the following sections:

1. Using the map application tools.
2. Identifying the intended pesticide application area.
3. Selecting the application month.
4. Refining your search.
5. Selecting a PULA.
6. Printing a Bulletin.
7. Understanding the components of the PDF Bulletin.
8. Additional information.
