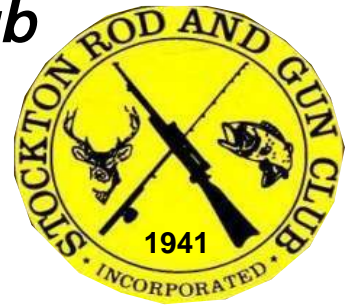

Fishing Report

DELTA, Sacramento Side — Sturgeon fishing has been slow since heavy inflow bringing cold water and debris has dominated the Delta. The two large sturgeon derbies are coming in early February, and with the dry spell predicted, the action for the diamondbacks should be outstanding. Striped bass trolling is on hold until at least February due to the high and muddy water, but the spring run should be outstanding.

DELTA, San Joaquin side — Largemouth bass action has slowed to a crawl with intensely muddy water conditions throughout the south Delta. It will take a few weeks for the waters to clear enough to find a decent bite. Striped bass is also slow, but this will change in the coming weeks. Noise, vibration, and scent are important to entice strikes.

New Fishing License Info 365-Day Sport Fishing Licenses

(valid January 1, through December 31, 2023, if purchased between November 15, 2022 and December 31, 2022, or for 365 days if purchased after January 1, 2023)

A sport fishing license is required for any person attempting to take fish, mollusks, crustaceans, invertebrates, amphibians, or reptiles in inland or ocean waters. Additional validations and report cards are required for certain species and areas.
