Fishing Report

DELTA, Sacramento Side — Sturgeon fishing remains solid from Pittsburg to the Benicia/Martinez Bridge as the diamondbacks are starting to spread out with the fresh water inflow. The bulk of fresh water flow has yet to arrive from the upper river, and it will create a few days of challenge with mud, sediment, and weeds. The evening tides have been optimal, and night trips are producing best for sturgeon.

Striped bass are slowing down with the cold 50-degree water, but the trophies will be arriving shortly in the north Delta sloughs after this rain to feed in the shallows.

Brannan Island State Park is now open in all areas as the new concessionaire has assumed responsibility.

DELTA, San Joaquin side — Striped bass remain on the west side of the San Joaquin system, and drifting live bait remains the top technique for the linesides in the rapidly cooling water. Topwater lures, glide baits, or 5-inch Bad Bubba Shad swimbaits will work once clear water is located in the back cuts and sloughs.

Crappie are biting live minnows off of Eight Mile Road. Largemouth bass action has slowed with the 50-degree water temperatures. A finesse presentation with ripbaits, jerkbaits, or plastics is essential. Noise, vibration, and scent are important to entice strikes.

(valid January 1, through December 31, 2023, if purchased between November 15, 2022 and December 31, 2022, or for 365 days if purchased after January 1, 2023)

A sport fishing license is required for any person attempting to take fish, mollusks, crustaceans, invertebrates, amphibians, or reptiles in inland or ocean waters. Additional validations and report cards are required for certain species and areas.
