Fishing Report

California Delta:

DELTA, San Joaquin side — Striped bass can be found from the Antioch Bridge to Three-Mile Slough, but there are also stripers moving into the Mokelumne River and as far east as downtown Stockton. One of the keys is looking for birds working the shad schools or sitting along the shorelines. Largemouth bass fishing is good for numbers, but size is limited. Bass in the 1.5 to 2.25-pound range are possible with jerkbaits, chatterbaits, or punching the weeds. The floating weeds are thick in the south Delta due to dying vegetation from the intense herbicide spraying. Fresh shad is over in local shops, but there is a big supply of frozen shad.
