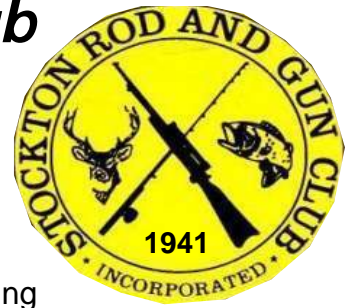

### **Fishing Report**

**DELTA, Sacramento Side — Striped bass remain either in Suisun or San Francisco Bays or up the river from Knight's Landing to Colusa as the Delta pickings have been extremely slim. Largemouth bass are found in the extreme north Delta in waters inaccessible in prior years, but the heavy inflow from all of the tributaries has opened access to flooded islands. Sturgeon remain in numbers in Suisun Bay, but interest has been limited although the fish are there. Anglers are requested to release the large gravid females on their way to spawn in the upper river. With sturgeon regulations set to change in 2025, anglers are requested to complete the Angler Survey. The link for the survey is <https://wildlife.ca.gov/Conservation/Fishes/Sturgeon>.**

**DELTA, San Joaquin side — Afternoon winds and a fluctuating water temperature has plagued Delta bass anglers with winning tournament weights averaging from 15 to 17 pounds, far below the normal summertime standards. The key has been to slow down as the bite has been so tough that some of the best anglers in the West have been struggling for one to three fish. The water is still very high, and the weeds have gotten knocked down with the high water and cold water temperatures. The weeds are a cleaning factor so finding clear water has been more difficult. The clearest water has been in the central Delta, and crankbaits, popper-style baits, or plastics such as the Berkley General with Max Scent are working, but you have to slow down and keep the bait in the strike zone as long as possible. Striped bass fishing has slowed considerably as the linesides have moved out either upriver to spawn or back to the bay to feed in post-spawn mode.**
