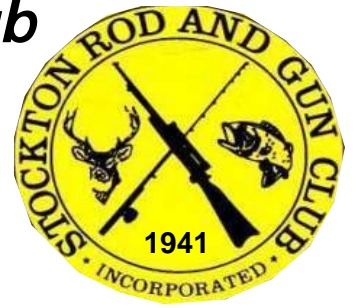

## Fishing Report

DELTA, Sacramento Side — The largemouth bite continues to improve in the north Delta, and chatterbaits or umbrella rigs are working. Large female stripers are starting to migrate through the system, and huge topwater lures such as MegaBait's Mega Dog have produced linesides to 30 pounds. The schools of striped bass are moving rapidly, and they are there one day before moving on. When the schools are present, trolling on the West Bank has been solid for numbers. The majority of stripers have been smaller males, but the larger females are on their way. Most sturgeon six-packs have vacated Pittsburg, but the sturgeon haven't left the area.

DELTA, San Joaquin side — Largemouth bass action is ready to break out as the water continues to clear up throughout the south and east Delta. Squarebilled crankbaits or bladed jigs such as the ima Slobberknocker are working when bounced off of structure. Striped bass trolling has been productive on the San Joaquin from the Antioch Bridge to the mouth of the Mokelumne River. Drifting bluegill or jumbo minnows are also productive throughout the San Joaquin system. The south San Joaquin River below Mossdale remains high and dirty with minimal action.

(valid January 1, through December 31, 2023, if purchased between November 15, 2022 and December 31, 2022, or for 365 days if purchased after January 1, 2023)

A sport fishing license is required for any person attempting to take fish, mollusks, crustaceans, invertebrates, amphibians, or reptiles in inland or ocean waters. Additional validations and report cards are required for certain species and areas.
