

Winter Abandonment, Investigation, and Remediation Program, Ring Border, BC



Project Profile

67 abandoned Wellsites required regulatory closure.

Issue

All 67 sites were located in winter-access only areas north of Fort St. John.

Solution

The Client decided on an aggressive winter program whereby once winter access was opened up, sites would be cut and capped, have intrusive investigations completed, and if necessary, remediated via excavation and off-Site disposal. Once determined to meet CSR standards, reclamation was completed on many of the sites during the same winter season.

Outcome

The aggressive approach to the winter program lead to 67 of the sites being investigated and / or remediated, with 20 COR Part 1's received and 26 more in the regulatory process.
