- **Finance Committee & Office** – The budget has been approved by the diocese and all other matters are in good standing.

- **Choir** - Father Dan reported that there are 3 choir groups, kids, contemporary, and traditional. All groups for-the-most-part will be taking a summer break. Maggie is doing a great job given all the challenges of the past year and is well organized and excited for the next year.
- **Art & Environment** - Father Dan reported that the end the liturgical season is approaching and that the decorations are being changed. Summer fest decorations will be up soon for easy removal.

**CEMETARY:** Julie **LAMPLEY** reported on a mower needed to be repaired and that the bank account is being changed to line up with the other accounts.

### **EDUCATION:** Lisa **BERG**

- **Religious Education** – The Catechists thank you dinner is scheduled for June 24<sup>th</sup>. FFF program registration is underway and has 53 families registered which is down from the previous year total count of 73. OSV books have been ordered. There is a need for a 4<sup>th</sup> grade and a Kindergarten RE teacher. All classes are planned to be held in person.
- **RCIA** – Lisa will start the RCIA program and Father Dan will pick up the program upon his return.

- **Family Ministry** – Debbie advised that snow cones and hot dogs will be sold at Summerfest and they will be organizing the kids games.

- The Blessing in a Backpack program was discussed with the River Valley Clergy Alliance that included 6 to 7 food items. No action was taken but support will be considered in the future.
- The Last Chance Men's Shelter needs volunteers to clean and ready the building.
- It will be decided in the next few weeks what the giving program will be for the Christmas Season.
