KING'S MOUNTAIN CELEBRATION.

CHARLOTTE, N. C., Sept. 28.—Arrangements for the sale of railroad tickets to the King's Mountain centennial celebration, which will take place Oct. 5 to 8, are complete, and the tickets will be offered by all roads south on Oct. 1, good from 10 to 30 days, according to the distance from King's Mountain, at 114 cents per mile each way. A special train will leave Charlotte, N. C., and Greenville, S. C., every morning for King's Mountain, returning at night. The platform at which visitors will get off is 228 miles from Atlanta, 39 miles from Charlotte, and 5 miles from the battle-ground. Ample conveyances from the station to the battleground will be provided. Every indication now points to a large and successful celebration.
