Food Deliveries in Haiti



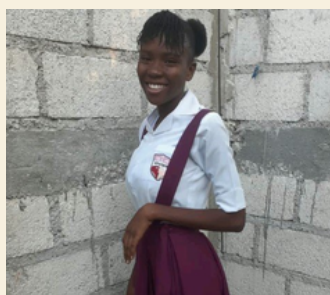
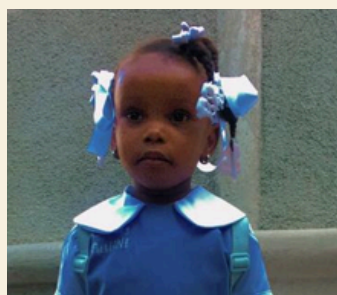
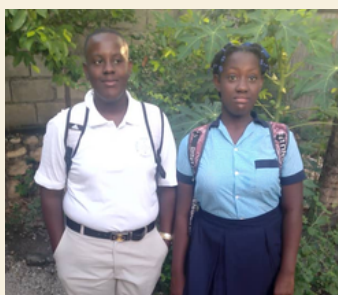

Partnering Project

In 2020, Honduras was struck by two deadly and destructive hurricanes within two weeks of each other. Eta, a category 4 hurricane with 149 miles per hour winds and rains that caused severe flooding and landslides, affected the poorest communities in vulnerable, at-risk areas. Thirteen days later, while the country was trying to recover from the devastation of Eta, Hurricane Lota struck Honduras. A category 5 hurricane, with winds of up to 161 mph, caused even more damage to the already affected communities. The Ebenezer school was substantially damaged.

In 2020, First Congregational Church of Naples initiated clean-up and repair efforts. While progress has been made, the need for a long-term solution for the Ebenezer school remains. In February of 2024, a team from Supply and Multiply, comprising Pastor Chris Surber, Salvador Toledo, Larry Denton, and Jason Weeks, visited the school. Their discussions focused on developing sustainable solutions to mitigate the impact of future rainfall.

The school currently has two unusable classrooms, which has affected its enrollment capacity and ability to offer a computer lab. The school has two sets of classrooms across the street from each other. The one set is of higher elevation and handles the weather fine. The other side sits lower than the road and creates pooling for flooding.

We plan to secure a roof to beams over the property. This will protect the property and redirect rainfall. Once we have a solution for the rainfall, we can remodel the classrooms so that they are usable. This project will be done in two phases. The first phase is estimated to be \$15,000. It will provide a roof over the property, a rain redirection system, and cement work to address the water flow. The second phase will be to repair the classrooms that have grown mold from the water damage, repair electrical lines, paint, replace the water-damaged chairs and desks, and reset up their computer lab. The second phase will be done in steps as funding allows.

Supply and Multiply works with indigenous missionaries to support them in carrying out their calling and shining Christ in their community. The Ebenezer School provides a safe Christ centered place for students to not just receive an education, but they also receive Christ and His principles.
