Supply and Multiply Haiti continues to provide essential aid and support to the community of Montrouis, Haiti. Despite ongoing challenges, we have remained dedicated to our mission. The Matthew 25 House in Montrouis, Haiti, our residential care center for the most vulnerable, is our brick-and-mortar location. God has opened doors for us to take what we have learned in Haiti with people who want to serve on the ground and head to other countries.

Supply and Multiply has expanded its efforts to reach other nations with the love and compassion of Jesus Christ. In 2023, we served alongside indigenous ministries in Jamaica and Honduras. We have plans to serve in Poland in early 2024. The world is hurting and in need of the Good News!

We continue to support those in Haiti to address the urgent needs arising from natural disasters, political instability, and economic hardships. The ministry in Haiti is focusing on providing food, shelter, medical assistance, refugee relocation, and educational support to those affected by these crises. The needs we address in other countries are project-based. We are not establishing ministry bases in other nations.

Looking ahead, Supply and Multiply is strategizing for long-term sustainability and resilience. We are exploring innovative ways to empower local communities, enhance disaster preparedness, and foster economic development to create a more stable future for people. We seek collaborations with local authorities, international organizations, Mission Agencies, NGOs, and other stakeholders to maximize our impact. By working together, we leverage resources and expertise for greater effectiveness.




