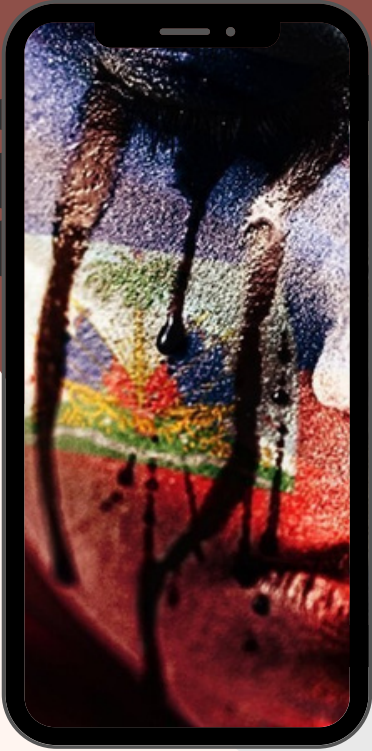

Community Care

The needs of the community are growing everyday. We provide medical care, food subsites, home repairs, and meet other needs as they arise. We provide water from the river via a generator to assist with gardens. We assist the local churches to provide care to the prisoners and for Haitian evangelism teams. As the Lord provides, we also build homes for families, repair churches and schools, and assist businesses with tools, training, and equipment.

Elderly Care

Supply and Multiply has seven residents that we provide 24/7 care for and strive to meet all of their needs. We show the love and compassion of Christ. Recently one of the elderly that lived with family went to be with the Lord. We assisted the family with his funeral.

Education

With your help we provide sponsorship for students to attend school. In addition, we partner with schools with needs such as books, building repairs, and other needs.

Refugee Care

The crisis in Haiti is causing many to flee their communities and country. We are presently following God's leading to directly support the safety of some fleeing families. In addition, to we are supporting individuals on Humanitarian Parole.

\$30 Allows us to bless community laborers with a meal or monthly sends a student to school

\$50 a day is the average daily cost to provide basic care for our residents

\$75 Blesses a family with food care package

\$100 Provides fuel for the generator to provide water to the gardens

\$150 Provides for the evangelism team to minister at the prison

\$300 Rents a house for a family for a year.

\$500 Assist a family with a funeral

Refugee Ministry

We provide various crisis and transition assistance such as housing, food, medical, clothing, school, insurance, and immigration paperwork.

Humanitarian Parole is a grant of temporary permission to enter the United States for urgent humanitarian reasons. As of January 6, 2023, this program was open to Haiti. This program allows Haitians who have legal residents or citizens of the United States to sponsor an individual or family to come to the United States. (A minor child cannot travel without a parent, this is not a path to adoption.) This program is currently for a two-year period of time and allows parolees to attend school and/or obtain work permits. For individuals whom God opens the doors for it is a beautiful opportunity. During this time of gang control and violence in Haiti, individuals can come to the US and seek safety, work to provide for their family, attend college, children can attend school, and they can unlock so many other opportunities available.

We currently have 9 individuals in the program and several others who desire to be part of this program and meet the requirements. Is God calling you to be a host family or sponsor to an individual or group? Do you feel led to help people financially transition?
