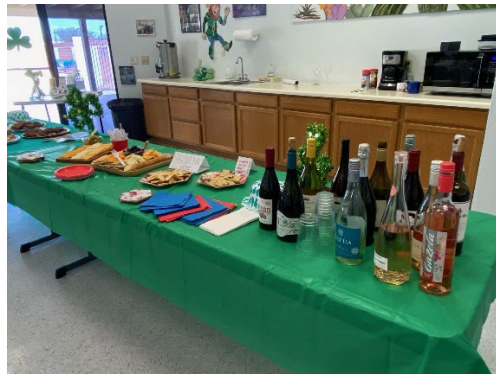

The GREAT GAME of BINGO

Come on down on Mondays at 1:00 pm and be prepared to have a lot of fun! (and maybe win something)

In March, the Regular Bingo game payouts were:

March 4 th	<u>\$15.00</u>	March 11 th	<u>\$20.00</u>
March 18 th	<u>\$15.00</u>	March 25 th	<u>\$21.00</u>

The regular Blackout game payouts were:

March 4 th	\$55.00	March 11 th	\$72.00
March 18 th	\$42.00	March 25 th	\$56.00

(No one won the Progressive Pot)

Each Bingo packet consists of 6 sheets, each sheet has 3 separate games you can play. They play 5 regular games and the final game is the blackout.

The 6 sheets sell for \$10.00 and includes 1 blackout sheet, an additional blackout sheet is \$1.00.

The \$1.00 for each extra blackout game card purchased goes into a separate Progressive Pot fund, which is now sitting at \$40.00.

They draw a number prior to playing the first Bingo game and that number is the "Powerball" number.

You can win the Progressive Powerball pot on any game that is played as long as you BINGO on the Powerball number.

If no one wins the Progressive Pot, the extra blackout card funds get added to the Progressive Pot for the next week.
