

Villager of the Year

The Villager of the Year program, sponsored by the Association, recognizes individual residents or group of residents who exemplify what it means to be a Villager by volunteering their time and talent to create the 'Good Life in the Villages'. The program started in 1990. Any resident of the Villages has the opportunity to nominate a candidate(s) for Villager of the Year. In the spring of each year the Board requests nominations for Villager of the Year for the prior year. A Committee of non Board members evaluates the nominations and selects the Villager of the Year. The selected Villager of the Year is presented a plaque acknowledging their contributions at a Board Meeting in April. A plaque is also added to the Villager of the Year recognition wall in Lounge 1.
