Ban on heavy vehicles during non-business hours.

Approved by the Sierra Crest Board of Directors on October 21, 2021.

- 1. With the exceptions noted below, no heavy or oversize vehicles will be permitted access to the Sierra Crest subdivision:
 - 1. Before 7:00 a.m. or later than 7:00 p.m. Monday Saturday.
 - 2. On Sundays or National or State Holidays
- 2. The Guard service will enforce this rule and deny access to applicable vehicles.
- 3. Heavy trucks/oversize vehicles are defined as:
 - 1. Trucks or vans with trailers
 - 2. Trucks or vans larger than a 1-ton pickup
 - 3. Commercial, non-passenger vehicles such as cement trucks, cranes, construction and boom lifts, backhoes/loaders, Port-a-John service vehicles, etc.
 - 4. Vehicles with three or more axles.
- 4. Exceptions:
 - 1. Emergency service vehicles and utility vehicles
 - 2. Commercial parcel delivery vehicles (UPS, FEDEX, DHS, USPS, Amazon, etc.)
 - 3. Busses and passenger vans
 - 4. An owner may request a one-day exception by contacting the Guard House the day before. The request must be made by the owner, not a representative or contractor, after due consideration of the vehicles' impact on traffic and noise in the neighborhood. Multi-day exceptions are not permitted without approval of a member of the SCHOA Board of Directors.
