





## PLARNING THE DAY AWAY.... FOR A GOOD CAUSE

It's amazing what can happen when dedicated, like-minded people come together to help others. A group of women at the Spring Hill Community Senior Center can attest to that. Since last September, these women have gathered together twice a month to turn plastic grocery store bags into works of art that have a practical use. The process begins by creating "plarn."

"When I started working here in January," says Michele Tufano, a part-time Recreation Assistant," I had never heard that word before. And when I saw what they were doing, I said are you

kidding me? I was blown away."

Plarn is plastic yarn. It's made with the small plastic bags you bring home from the grocery store.

"Our dozen-plus volunteers take the plastic bags, fold them in half, and cut the bags into strips," says Fran Gospodarek, a member at the center. "The strips are joined together to make balls of plarn. And the volunteers who know the art of crocheting, then crochet them into mat and pillow sets."

The mats measure approximately 3 feet by 6 feet and have ties or straps added to make them easy to carry. Every mat comes with a companion pillow. Creating each set not only takes a lot of time and effort, but it also takes a considerable number of bags.

"As you can imagine, many plastic bags are required," says Gospodarek. "At least 1000 for each set."

The sets are all donated to help the homeless in the greater Nashville area. In addition, the Spring Hill group works with Shower Up, which provides mobile shower units and personal hygiene necessities to those in need.

It's a way to do something for others and falls under the heading "love thy neighbor." To help carry the message behind it, the volunteers attach small wooden hearts with the word "love" to each and every mat.

The Spring Hill Community Senior Center is open to people over 55 and is free to join. Members have access to a number of

activities and can play cards, take part in ballroom dance classes, join a book or travel club, and much more. They can also learn the art of making plarn. Organizers welcome new volunteers to help with either turning the grocery bags into the yard or crocheting the actual mats and pillows. The group meets on the first and third Tuesday of the month from 1 pm to 2:30 pm. The center is located at 563 Maury Hill Street.

"They all work together so well, with each taking part in the different steps," Tufano says. "There's a lot of laughter, joy, and friendship, and they're excited about what they're doing and ready to welcome new people to the group."





## Red Snapper with Veggies and Creamy Pasta

**INGREDIENTS: SERVES: 2 PERSONS** 

**PROTEIN:** 

RED SNAPPER FILET- 2 FILETS

JUMBO SHRIMP-1LB

**VEGETABLES:**CORN ON THE COB-1 UN-SHUCKED CORN (CUT

CORN OFF THE COB RAW)

WHOLE RED PEPPER- 1 (FINE DICE)

ASPARAGUS- 3 SKINNY STALKS (CUT OFF TOP AND BOTTOM ENDS,

CUT INTO 1/2 INCH PIECES)

GREEN ONION- 3 STRANDS FOR GARNISH (CHOP AND SET ASIDE) LEMON- 1 WHOLE (CUT OFF ENDS AND CUT THE LEMON INTO 4

QUARTERS)

PASTA: SMALL SHELL PASTA- 2 CUPS

**SAUCE:** WHITE RUE- 2 OZ (MAKE IN A MEDIUM SIZED POT, KEEP IN POT ONCE FINISHED FOR LATER USE. TAKE OFF THE HEAT SOURCE.)

2% MILK- 2 CUPS

SPICES:

CAJUN-8 OZ

OLIVE OIL- 7 OZ RED PEPPER- 5 OZ SALT AND PEPPER- TO TASTE ROSEMARY- 2 TBSP ALL SPICE- ½ TSP

## **DIRECTIONS:** Once one item is started, begin the next one if you have the space. Note: All of these components take up 5 eyes on a stove.

- **Sauteed Shrimp** In a small sauté pan on medium heat put 2 oz of olive oil in the pan. Once the pan is ready add the shrimp. Add both ends of the lemon and 1 of the 4 wedges. Squeeze the juice in the shrimp and leave the peel in the shrimp too.
- Pan seared Snapper- In a large sized sauté pan on medium heat, put 4 oz of the olive oil in the pan and allow to heat up. In the meantime, salt and pepper the fish to taste and add 2 oz of Cajun seasoning to one side of filets, then 2 oz more of Cajun to the other side. Cook the fish till the layers of the fish separate with ease and become opaque.
- **Sauteed Veggies** In a small sauté pan on medium heat, put 1 Tbsp of olive oil in the pan and allow to heat up. Once the pan is ready, combine the asparagus, corn, and red pepper in the pan. Allow veggies to get some color.
- **Cream Sauce** Begin to heat up the white rue on medium heat, once up to temperature, pour in the milk and reduce heat to low. Stir constantly until thickened. Season to taste and add rosemary, 1 lemon wedge squeezed and its peel, and all spice.
- **Pasta** In a smaller pot, begin boiling the water and add a pinch of salt. Once the water boils, cook the pasta till tender, strain and set aside.
- **Layer** from bottom to top (1 cup of pasta, half of the sauce, 1 fish for each plate or bowl, half veggie mix on top of 1 fish, split shrimp, make a ring around the center with shrimp, sprinkle with green onion, lemon on top.)






