Combined Cherokee County/WTHOA Pool Rules

- 1. Parents/guardians must insure that infants/children using the pool do NOT have a diarrheal illness.
- 2. All infants/children not toilet trained and incontinent individuals must wear swim diapers and plastic swim pants.
- 3. Pool is for the use of Williams Towne Owner members and their guests. Guests are limited to 3 per household.
- 4. No one may use the pool unless it is officially open.
- 5. No lifeguard is on duty, swim at your own risk.
- 6. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 7. Proper swimming attire must be worn.
- 8. Shower and rinse thoroughly before entering the pool.
- 9. No animals other than service animals allowed in pool area.
- 10. No diving.
- 11. No running, horseplay, or unsafe behavior.
- 12. No profanity.
- 13. Do not enter the pool with open sores/wounds, skin infections or any other condition that may jeopardize the health and safety of others.
- 14. No spitting, spouting or blowing nose.
- 15. No smoking.
- 16. Pool hours are 8am to dusk.
- 17. In case of an emergency there is a first aid box and a 911 only phone located on the right wall of the pool house.
- 18. No glass, sharp objects or hazardous materials allowed.
- 19. Clean up trash and close umbrellas when you leave. Failure to adhere to the pool rules could result in forfeiture of pool privileges.

The pool may be reserved for private parties pending Board approval. To reserve the pool contact a Board member at least 10 days in advance of your party.
