REMINDERS

ABSOLUTELY NO BROADHEADS ARE TO BE SHOT ON THE PRACTICE RANGE.

There is a range specially designated for broadheads located just off the upper parking lot. Anyone seen shooting broadheads anywhere other than on the broadhead range will have their membership privileges suspended.

If a broadhead comes off your arrow when you shot into the foam block, **DO NOT** attempt to get it back by digging a hole in the foam. We understand that broadheads are expensive, but so are the foam blocks that the club provides. Digging a large hole in the foam ruins the target and will be considered vandalism if caught doing so club privileges maybe revoked.

Do not stand anywhere other than on the concrete, under the roof when using the practice range. The roof was built to prevent errant arrows from flying onto the neighbors property. Anyone seen shooting from the parking lot or out in the grass will face possible suspension of their membership.

Please remember to fill out catch reports. These are not kept reports. It is for fish kept or released reports. Failure to do so may result in suspension.

Reminder boats need to be registered and paid for with the club yearly and need to be kept in the designated area by the broadhead range.
