The Annotated Edition was created for all American Civil War devotees and novices interested in learning more about the U.S. Marines' historic, yet scarcely publicized, involvement in this event. Over 520 informative annotations have been embedded (displayed in a smaller, gray-shaded typeface) in the text rather than footnoted at the bottom of the page or stacked in numbered order at the end of each chapter or the book.

In addition, the annotated edition's unique 57-page appendix is referenced throughout the story. The add-on contains numerous photographs, depictions, and other educative materials.

The Annotations and Appendix are designed to enrich each reader's enjoyment beyond the story's plot line. They are also intended to further enlighten all readers about the Marines of that era and the "other" key participants – the B&O Railroad, the township of Harper's Ferry, and the U.S. Armory/Arsenal.
