- An art museum in Louisiana needed a donor recognition display to compliment the stainless steel hardware throughout the contemporary building. We designed a custom 9' x 8' stainless steel display with removable stainless steel nameplates for 5 different giving categories that allow them to easily update the display.
- A major law school in the southwest wanted a recognition piece that allowed them to continually acknowledge
 annual donors to the Chancellors society. We created a custom mahogany wood base with brass plate that
 included an etched glass piece that fits into the base and is awarded annually to donors. This award has been
 successful in establishing over 250 annual donors.
- The college at a large Texas university wanted to recognize their endowed scholarships. We designed a contemporary wall display that contained multiple glass panels covering a 20' x 6' are to acknowledge their current donors and allowed room for the future growth of their programs.
- A major private university in Texas wanted a cast bronze wall display to acknowledge two major philanthropists of the institution. Working with their graphics department, we created several large 3' x 6' cast bronze plaques with portraits that were attached to a custom-built wall to honor these special donors.
- A major hospital in Dallas needed a donor wall and naming opportunity signage for a new outside park they were
 creating. We worked with their designers and created a durable stainless steel free-standing display and naming
 plaques that timelessly recognize their contributors.
- A north Texas private Christian school completed their capital campaign and wanted to recognize their donors and identify naming opportunities. Using cast aluminum, we designed and crated signage which also matched and complemented their existing recognition.
- A DFW area school district wanted a display to honor their championship footfall team. We designed a large cast
 bronze plaque that listed the players, coaches, staff and schedule to memorialize this special season. The display
 was mounted at the stadium for their fans to enjoy. Additionally, we added individual cast bronze "Hall of Fame"
 plaques to commemorate persons of special significance to their sports program.

DONOR RECOGNITION

Annual Giving

- Individual items recognizing various levels of annual giving, e.g. \$100, \$500, \$1,000, \$5,000, \$10,000, etc.

- Individual portrait plaques, awards for honoree.
- Illustration wall display honoring past, present and allowing room for future award recipients.

Board Member Service Recognition

• Individual items recognizing board members for service during their terms.

- Elaborate central display with portrait and text plates. May contain historical or event driven content.
- Recipients receive an individual portrait plaque/awards with a replica included on a central display.

Special Athletic Achievement Awards

- Individual recognition pieces recognizing MVP, student-athlete awards, etc.
- Central displays recognizing past, present and allowing room for future award recipients.

SPECIAL AWARDS

- Individual desk, plaques, awards, glass pieces presented to honoree.
- Service, Safety or Length of Service individual awards and wall displays
- Central display honoring past, present and allowing for future award recipients.

SIGNAGE

- Major donor recognition, building and campus identification, special objects/scenes can be incorporated.
- Exterior Usage: cast bronze or aluminum; stainless steel, etched metal, ImageCast, Alumicolor, corian and combinations of these materials.
- Interior Usage: cast bronze or aluminum; stainless steel, etched metal, ImageCast, Alumicolor, glass, acrylic, wood, laminates, corian and combinations of these materials.
