Fenelon Fair will feature an Open Hereford Show, Junior Hereford Show and All Other Registered Breeds.

- 1 – All cattle must be securely tied, and must be shown with a suitable halter.
- 2 – Each exhibitor to pay membership fee of \$8.00 at the time of making entries.
- 3 – Entry Fee – 10% of prize money won
- 4 – Exhibitor may enter a maximum of two animals per section unless otherwise noted.
- 5 – Calves from sections 9 and 10 will not be allowed to be shown singularly except as part of the Breeders Herd and Get of Sire.
- 6 – All exhibitors must have Off Farm Liability Insurance. Please provide Policy number on entry form.
- 7 – Pedigrees for animals may be requested.
- 8 – CCIA Tag numbers need to be included on your entry form.
- 9 – No cattle may be removed from the grounds before 4 PM. In the event of extreme heat cattle may be released early at the discretion of the Committee Chairman.
- 10 – The Premises ID # for the Fenelon Fairgrounds is ON212874. Exhibitors please list the premises ID number on your entry form that pertains to your herd.
