A Prayer for Our Children: Restore, Revive, Refresh, Renew

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding

in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Philp. 2:10) we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children of the United States of America. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Beloved Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that **Christ** might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek, 13:5) for Our Children (Is, 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so

that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

Save Our Children (Is. 61:9), and bless Your inheritance, O Lord; Shepherd them also, and bear them up forever. Grace be with Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Titus 3:15). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and keep them; the Lord make His face shine upon them, and be gracious to them; the Lord lift up His countenance upon them,

and give them peace; the Lord put His name on Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and bless them (Num. 6:24-27). Grace be with them (Col. 4:18)! Glory to God the Father (Luke 2:14)! Hear our voice according to Your loving-kindness; O Lord, revive Our Children (Is. 61:9), according to Your justice (Ps. 119:149-150). In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), the Son of the Most-High, may the God of peace who brought up our *Lord Jesus* from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) complete in every good work to do His will, working in them and their family (Acts 13:26) what is well pleasing in His sight, through **Jesus Christ**, to whom be glory forever and ever (Heb. 13:20-21). May God, who is ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, abundant in kindness (Neh. 9:17), restore their soul and lead them and their people (Ps. 148:14) in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake (Ps. 23:3). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) our God and Father (Phil. 4:20) will prepare a table before Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) in the presence of their enemies; may He anoint their head with oil; may their cup run over. Surely, goodness and mercy shall follow them and theirs all the days of their life; and they will dwell in the house of the Lord forever (Ps. 23:5-6). Let their flesh be young like a child's, may them and theirs return to the days of youth. May they and their family (Acts 13:26) pray to God, and He will delight in them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall see His face with joy, for He restores to them His righteousness (Job 33:25-26). Yes, in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Jehovah-Mekoddishkem, the Lord Who Sanctifies You (Ec. 31:13), will restore to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) the joy of His salvation, and uphold them and theirs with His Generous Spirit (Ps. 51:12). According to His abundant mercy (1 Pet 1:3) may the Lord our God (Math. 4:10) turn Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) back to Him, and they will be restored and He will renew their days of old (Lam. 5:21). In returning and rest, they shall be saved; in quietness and confidence shall be their strength (Is. 30:15). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) praise the Lord according to their righteousness! Sing praises to the name of the Lord Most-High (Ps. 7:17)!

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), may the Lord our God bestow mercy on their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) hold and refresh them often (2 Tim. 1:16), for Jehovah God did not forsake Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in their bondage, but He extended mercy to them and their people (Ps. 148:14), to revive them, to repair, restore (2 Chr. 34:10) and reinforce (2 Chr. 24:13) their house (Gen 14:14, 2

Sam. 6:21), a building from God, a house not made with hands, but eternal in the heavens (2) Cor. 5:1), to rebuild its ruins and to give them and their people (Ps. 148:14) a wall in Jerusalem (Ezra 9:9), the New Jerusalem (Rev. 3:12). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God Almighty will restore to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the crawling locust, the consuming locust, and the chewing locust. May the Lord revive His work in Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in the midst of the years! In the midst of years may He make it known and remember mercy (Hab. 3:2), and restore double to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Zech. 9:12) and their family (Acts 13:26). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we implore the God Most-High to restore to their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) all the land and territory (2 Sam. 9:7) that was given to them as an inheritance (Gen. 13:17). For the LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (Jer. 23:6) shall bring Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) in and plant them in the mountain of His inheritance, in the place which He has made for His own dwelling, the sanctuary which His hands have established (Ex. 15:17). May He restore to them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) all that was theirs, and all the proceeds of the field from the day that they left the land until now (2 Kin. 8:6). May it please the Lord to restore their losses and give them twice as much as before (Job 42:10). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we make request for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) that God the Judge of all (Heb. 12:23) restore every man's money (Gen. 42:25) in their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) from the beginning of time, all the wealth of their house (Job 20:10), and may all their possessions be returned to their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in the year of Jubilee (Lev. 25:28). That which has been stolen from them and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), let the thief restore sevenfold, even though he may have to give up all the substance of his house (Prov. 6:31). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) delight themselves also in the Lord and He shall give them the desires of their heart (Ps. 37:4), and our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) will grant to them and their people (Ps. 148:14) according to their heart's desire, and fulfill all of their purpose (Ps. 20:4). He shall increase their greatness and comfort Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) on every side (Ps. 71:21). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) wait on the Lord and He shall renew their strength; they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not weary, they shall walk and not faint (ls. 40:31). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16), in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 12:20) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will be rested (Ex. 31:17), refreshed and well (1 Sam.

16:23); that the Lord God will refresh and revive their hearts (Gen. 18:5, Is. 57:15), their spirits (1 Cor. 16:18), and their souls (Prov.25:13). Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall eat plenty and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord their God, who has dealt wondrously with His people, whom they are, and Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall never be put to shame (Joel 2:25-26), instead excellent majesty will be added to them (Dan. 4:36). Grace and peace be multiplied to Our Children (Is. 61:9) in the knowledge of God and of *Jesus Our Lord* (2 Pet. 1:2). The Lord is righteous in all His ways, gracious in all His works. The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth (Ps. 145:17-18). The Lord preserves all who love Him. Let their mouth speak the praise of the Lord, and bless His holy name forever and ever (Ps. 134:20-21)!

In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), in the name of *Jesus* (John 16:23), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1;29), that God will restore the excellence (Nah. 2:2) of their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The thief does not come except to steal, and kill, and destroy, **Jesus** comes to their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly (John 10:10). When the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which they have done, but according to His Mercy He saved them, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) abundantly through Jesus Christ Their Savior, that having been justified by His grace, Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life (Titus 3:4-7). The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works. All His works shall praise Him, and His saints shall bless Him! Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall speak of the glory of His kingdom, and talk of His power, to make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His kingdom! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and His dominion endures throughout all generations (Ps. 145:9-13)!

In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we entreat the favor of the Lord our God, in the name of His only begotten son, <u>Jesus Christ</u> (1 John 4:9), and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (1 Kin. 13:6) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) that where sickness and disease has struck, that their flesh shall be restored to them, and they shall be clean (2 Kin. 5:10); that God will restore health to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and heal them of their wounds (Jer. 30:127); that they be revived and stand on their feet (2 Kin. 13:21). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will return to the Lord, and where

He has torn, He will heal them and their people (Ps. 148:14), and where He has stricken, He will bind them and their people (Ps. 148:14) up (Hos. 6:1). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) shall neither hunger nor thirst, neither heat or sun shall strike them (Is. 49:10) by day, nor the moon by night (Ps. 121:6), for He who has mercy on them, will lead them, even by the springs of water He will guide them (Is. 49:10). Let us meditate on the glorious splendor of His majesty, and on His wondrous works. We shall speak of the might of His awesome acts, and we will declare His greatness. We shall utter the memory of His great goodness, and shall sing of His righteousness (Ps. 145:5-7)!

El Roi, the God who sees (Gen. 16:13), has seen their ways (Is. 57:18), and in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), in the precious name of Jesus (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), that where Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) have been backsliding in the way of their heart (ls. 57:17), Jehovah will heal them (ls. 57:18), for the God of justice (ls. 30:18) will teach transgressors His ways, for His ways are everlasting (Hab. 3:6), and sinners shall be converted to Him (Ps. 51:13). Where God has chastised Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), like an untrained bull, and although they may be ashamed and humiliated, because they bear the reproach of their youth, may God restore them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Lord their God, that Our Children (Is. 61:9) may turn, repent, receive instruction (Jer. 31:18-19) and be comforted in His comfort (2 Cor. 7:13), for the Lord Jesus, their Redeemer (Gal 4:5), is a restorer of life and a nourisher of their old age (Ruth 4:15). May the God of life (Ps. 42:8) show them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) His ways, teach them and their people (Ps. 148:14) His paths. Lead them and theirs in His truth and teach them, for He is the God of their salvation (Ps. 25:4). He will also lead Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14), and restore comforts to them. Keep silence before God, O coast lands, and let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) renew their strength! Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) come near to God, then let them speak; let them come near together for judgment (ls. 41:1). "I create the fruit of the lips: peace, peace to them who is far off and to them who is near" says the Lord "And I will heal them" (Is. 57:18-19). Sing O heavens! Be joyful, O earth! And break out in singing, O mountains! For the Lord has comforted His people, and will have mercy on His afflicted (Is. 49:13). The Lord comfort Our Children (Is. 61:9). May their lips greatly rejoice when they sing to the Lord, and their soul, which He has redeemed! Let their tongues also talk of His righteousness all the day long (Ps. 71:23-24), their meditation be

sweet to Him (Ps. 104:34); and let them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) be glad in the Lord (Ps. 104:34)! For they are confounded, for they are brought to shame who seek their hurt (Ps. 71:23-24). May it please the God of their Salvation, the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy (Is. 57:15) to command the blessing upon Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Behold, He has blessed Our Children (Is. 61:9), and no one can reverse it (Num. 23:20). For there is no sorcery against Our Children (Is. 61:9) or their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), nor any divination against them (Num. 24:23) or their people (Ps. 148:14) that will prosper (Is. 54:17). For Yours, Father in heaven, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever (Math 6:13)!

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), the covenant of the people (Is. 42:6), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Lord God of Hosts restore Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); that He will revive them and their people (Ps. 148:14) and cause His face to shine upon them (Ps. 80:18-19) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Father of Righteousness (Prov. 23:24) will revive (Ps. 119:25) and strengthen Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) according to His word (Ps. 119:28). That the God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) will revive them and their people (Ps. 148:14) in His way (Ps. 119:37) and in His righteousness (Ps. 119:40), according to His loving kindness, so that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) may keep the testimony of His mouth. Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven! Your faithfulness endures to all generations (Ps. 119:88-90)! In their affliction Our Children (Is. 61:9) and the affliction of their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) may the Lord who heals (Ex. 15:26) revive them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) according to His justice (Ps. 119:149), and teach them His judgments (Ps. 119:107). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) commit their way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth their righteousness as the light, and their justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:6)! Though they and their family (Acts 13:26) walk in the midst of trouble, He will revive Our Children (Is. 61:9); He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of their enemies, and His right hand will save them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The Lord will perfect that which concerns Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14). His Mercy endures forever and He will not forsake the works of His hands (Ps. 138:7-8)! In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) God will cause Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) to hear His loving kindness in the morning; and cause them to know the way which they and their people (Ps. 148:14) should walk. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we implore Our Children (ls. 61:9) to lift up their soul to Elothem (Gen 1:1), God our creator

(Eccl. 12:1), and He will teach them to do His will and lead them in uprightness, revive them and their people (Ps. 148:14) for His righteousness' sake and bring their souls out of trouble (Ps. 143:8-11). The Lord upholds all who fall, and raises up all those who are bowed down. The eyes of all look expectantly to Him, and He gives them their food in due season. He will open His hand and satisfy the desire of (Ps. 145:14-16) their heart (Ps. 37:4). Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ* our Savior (Titus 1:4)!

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), let God's mercies come also to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), His salvation according to His word (Ps. 119:41). May the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17) send chariots of salvation (Hab. 3:8), the Spirit of truth (John 14:17), and walk in the midst of their camp (Deut. 23:14). May El Elyon, the Most-High God (Ps. 78:35), give to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) a banner, that it may be displayed because of the truth (Ps. 60:4). That His beloved, Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), may be delivered, that He will save them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) with His right hand and hear them (Ps. 60:5) and answer them. Our Children (ls. 61:9) shall cry and He will say "Here I am" (ls. 58:9). May the Lord of Hosts stir up His strength, and come and save Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21)! Restore them and their people (Ps. 148:14) to God; cause His face to shine upon them (Ps. 80:17) and their family (Acts 13:26). In His mercy may the God of glory thunders (Ps. 29:3) cut off their enemies and destroy all those who afflict their soul (Ps. 143:12). May God their Father (Phil. 4:20) create in Our Children (Is. 61:9) a clean heart, a pure heart (Math. 5:8) and renew a steadfast spirit within them and their people (Ps. 148:14). Let Him never cast Our Children (Is. 61:9) or their people (Ps. 148:14) away from His presence nor take His Holy Spirit from them (Ps. 51:10-11) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). May the Lord, their strength and their redeemer (Ps. 19:14), revive Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and raise them up, that they may live in His sight (Hos. 6:2). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) know and pursue the knowledge of the Lord. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) like the rain, like the latter and the former rain to the earth (Hos. 6:3). For the Lord their God will heal their backsliding; He will love Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) freely (Hos. 14:4). He will restore them and their family (Acts 13:26) in a spirit of gentleness (Gal. 6:1). He will be like the dew to their house; they shall grow like the lily, and lengthen their roots like Lebanon (Hos. 14:5). Their root shall spread out to the waters, and the dew shall lie all night on their branch (Job 29:19). Their branches shall spread; their beauty shall be

like an olive tree, and their fragrance like Lebanon. Their scent shall be like the wine of Lebanon. Their fruit is found in God, they being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by *Jesus Christ*, to the glory and praise of the Most-High God (Phil. 1:9-11). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) understand these things. May they know them. For the ways of the Lord are right; the righteous walk in them, but transgressors stumble in them (Hos. 14:5-9). The grace of the *Lord Jesus Christ*, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with them all (2 Cor. 13:14)! May it please God that in their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), this generation shall praise His works to another, and shall declare His mighty acts (Ps. 145:4). The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy (Ps. 145:8). He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them (Ps. 145:4) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21)!

Great is God's tender mercies. In the name of *Jesus* (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), may the Lord revive Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) according to His judgments (Ps. 119:156). Hear our voice according to Your loving kindness, O Lord (Ps. 119:149) for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10)! May the God of compassion let not Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) be robbed and plundered, snared in holes or hidden in prison house (Is. 49:6). Because of the blood of their covenant with God (Math. 26:28), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Peter 1:19), God Almighty will set Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) free form the waterless pit; may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) return to the stronghold of their God, and become prisoners of hope (Zech. 9:11-12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will extend their soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul, then their light shall dawn in the darkness, and their darkness shall be as the noonday. The Lord will guide Our Children (ls. 61:9) continually, and satisfy their soul in drought, and strengthen their bones; they shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. Those from among them shall build the old waste places; they shall raise up the foundations of many generations; and they shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, the Restorer of Streets to Dwell In (ls. 58:10-12). Out of their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of those who make merry; for the Lord their God will multiply Our Children (ls. 61:9), and they shall not diminish; He will also glorify them, and they shall not be small (Jer. 30:19). Let them extol

Him, their God, their King; and they will bless His name forever and ever! Every day they will bless Him, and they will praise His name forever and ever! Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable (Ps. 145:1-3)!

The Lord is well pleased for His righteousness' sake, He will magnify the law in their hearts (Prov. 7:3), and make them honorable (Is. 42:21). In His house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), the hearts of Our Children (Is. 61:9), may fathers make known His truth to the children (Is. 38:19). In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), the author and finisher of their faith (Heb. 12:2), may father and child alike, repent therefore and be converted, that their sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord (Acts 3:19). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) restore what they have stolen, or the things which they have extorted, or what was delivered to them for safekeeping, or the lost thing which they found, or all that about which they have sworn falsely. Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) restore its full value, add one-fifth more to it and give it to whomever it belongs (Lev. 6:4-5). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of their mind, that they may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God (Rom. 12:2). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) put off, concerning their former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of their mind (Eph. 4:22-23), that their inward man be renewed day by day (2 Cor. 4:16), precept upon precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little (Is. 28:10); and that they put on the new man which was created according to God, in righteousness and true holiness (Eph. 4:24). The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork! Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge (Ps. 19:1-2)! The Lord shall reign forever. Our God, to all generations (Ps. 146:10)! We ask, in the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), our savior and our redeemer, that God our Father (Phil. 4:20) will restore to Our Children (Is. 61:9) a pure language, that they all may call on the name of the Lord to serve Him with one accord (Zeph. 3:9). Now may the God of patience and comfort grant Our Children (Is. 61:9) to be like minded toward one another, according to **Christ Jesus**, that they may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Rom. 15:5). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that they all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among them, but that they be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in

the same judgment (1Cor. 1:10), being like-minded having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind (Phil. 2:2). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Jesus will put His hand on their eyes and make them look up to their Father and Creator, to see the things which are not seen, to see the things that are eternal (2 cor. 4:18), and that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) be restored and that they see everyone clearly. May the God of compassion (Deut. 32:36) restore them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) again (Ps. 60:1), and keep them from drinking the wine of confusion (Ps. 60:3). May the Lord send forth His Spirit and create (Ps. 104:30) in Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) a new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created them (Col. 3:10). God Almighty shall renew the face of the earth! The glory of the Lord endures forever; the Lord shall rejoice in His works - Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 104:30-31) and their people (Ps. 148:14)! May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) bless the Lord, with all their soul; and all that is within them, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, with all their soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all their iniquities, who heals all their diseases, who redeems their life from destruction, who crowns them with loving kindness and tender mercies, who satisfies their mouth with good things, so that their youth is renewed like the eagle's. The Lord executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed (Ps. 103:1-6). May Jehovah-Nisi, the Lord Is Our Banner (Ex. 17:15), plead their cause and redeem Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); revive them and their people (Ps. 148:14) according to His word (Ps. 119:154). When they are oppressed, may the Lord undertake for them (ls. 38:14). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Lord, who is good, and ready to forgive and abundant in mercy (Ps. 84;5), to restore their spirit from the bitterness of their soul (Is. 38:15), and make them live (Is. 38:6) an abundant life (John 10:10) rich in the fruits of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22). Let not a bitter root cling to them or take root in Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Heb. 12:15). For they know that their Redeemer lives (Job 19:24)! In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will purify their souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit of truth (John 14:17), in sincere love of the brethren, loving one another fervently with a pure heart, having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:23). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that *Jesus* Christ will dwell in their heart through faith (Eph. 3:17), and having been crucified with Christ it will no longer be them who lives, but *Christ* living in them; and the life which they now live in the flesh they shall live by faith in the Son of God, who loved them and gave

Himself for them (Gal. 2:20). For though <u>Christ</u> was crucified in weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For they also are weak in Him, but they shall live with Him by the power of God toward them. May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) examine themselves as to whether they are in the faith. Test themselves. Do they not know themselves, that <u>Jesus Christ</u> is in them (2 Cor. 13:4-5)? Let them join with every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them saying: "Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power, be unto Him that sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever" (Rev 5:13)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord** Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in *Christ* (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and

their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and **Christ** will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In *Christ* (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield belongs to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9), in the name of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), in whom new creation avails (Gal. 6:15), and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ, to bear His name (Acts 9;15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty **Psalms 89:34**. God is watching over His word to perform it Jerimiah. 1:12 and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it **Isaiah 55:11**. The Lord gives voice before His

army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word **Joel 2:11!** The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms 33:1.** It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls **Joel 2:32.** "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts **Malachi 1:11.** We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In **Jesus**' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)!

For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy:
"I dwell in the high and holy place, with them who has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones (Is. 57:15). At that time Jerusalem shall be called The Throne of the Lord, and all their family (Acts 13:26) shall be gathered to it, to the name of the Lord, to Jerusalem; they shall walk no more after the stubbornness of their evil heart (Jer. 3:17). For then God, will restore to their people (Ps. 148:14) a pure language, that they all may call on the name of the Lord, to serve Him with one accord (Zeph. 3:9). By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of Jesus Christ (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
