A Prayer for the Children of Israel

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of **Jesus Christ** (Philp. 2:10)

we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children Israel. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that *Christ* might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so

that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

Mercy surround Our Children (Is. 61:9); let them be glad in the Lord and rejoice and shout for joy and mercy shall surround them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) (Ps. 32:10-11). But know that the Lord has set apart for Himself those who are godly; the Lord will hear when we call to Him (Ps. 4:3). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call to the Lord our God (Gen. 4:26) and ask in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), His great and awesome name (Ps. 99:3), that according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:4), the Lord will choose Our Children (Is. 61:9), and

their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and cause (Ps. 65:4) them to come near to Him (Deut. 21:5); that the Lord will establish them and their family (Acts 13:26) as a holy people to Himself (Deut. 28:9). He will set them and their family (Acts 13:26) high in praise, in name and in honor, that they may be holy to the Lord their God, just as He has spoken (Deut. 26:19). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord will set His love upon Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and choose (Deut. 7:7) them and their family (Acts 13:26) for Himself, a special treasure (Deut. 14:2), and redeem them and their people (Ps. 148:14) from the house of bondage (Deut. 7:8). May God separate them and their family (Acts 13:26) that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall be holy and belong to God (Lev. 20:26). Oh Lord, send out Your light and Your truth (Ps. 43:3)! Let Jehovah-Raah, the Lord our Shepherd (Ps. 23:1), lead Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), by still waters (Ps 23:2) and bring them and their family (Acts 13:26) to His holy hill and to His tabernacle (Ps. 43:3). May the Lord lead them and their people (Ps. 148:14) in His righteousness and make their way straight before their face (Ps. 5:8). May the God of Israel give strength and power to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 68:35), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and cause them and their family (Acts 13:26) to approach Him, that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) may dwell in His courts (Ps. 93:13). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their people (Ps. 148:14) will be satisfied with the goodness of His house, of His holy temple (Ps. 65:4); that they and their family (Acts 13:26) will eat the bread of God, both the most holy and the holy (Lev. 21:22) and remember His covenant always, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:15) and not conceal the words of the Holy One (Job 6:10) but instead come into His house in the multitude of His mercy and in fear of Him they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall worship toward His holy temple (Ps. 5:7). Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:36)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), who gave Himself for their sins, that He might deliver them from this present evil age, according to the will of their God and Father (Gal. 1:4-5), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), will wash their hands in innocence (Ps. 26:6), they will not gather their soul together with sinners, nor their life with bloodthirsty men (Ps. 26:9). In His mercy may God lead Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), whom He has redeemed, guide them and their people

(Ps. 148:14) in His strength to His holy habitation (Ex. 15:13). May God give to them and their people (Ps. 148:14) His counsel, and let their heart also instruct themselves in the night season. Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) set the Lord always before themselves so that He will be at their right hand and they shall not be moved (Ps. 16:7-8). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that He may keep Our Children (Is. 61:9), from corruption and show them the path of life. In His presence is fullness of joy, at His right hand are pleasures forevermore (Ps. 16:10-11). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) cleanse themselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God (2 Cor. 7:1). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their people (Ps. 148:14) will walk uprightly (Ps. 84:11), work righteousness (Heb. 11:33), speaking truth in their hearts (Ps. 15:2), stirring up love and good works (Heb. 10:24), exhorting one another (Heb. 10:25), not backbiting with their tongues, nor doing evil to their neighbors, nor taking up a reproach against their friends (Ps. 15:3). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their people (Ps. 148:14) will distinguish between holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean and that they will teach their children God's statutes (Lev. 10:10-11); that they will revere their mother and their father, and keep His Sabbaths (Lev. 19:3). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) sanctify themselves and be holy, neither shall they defile themselves (Lev. 11:44), nor profane His holy name (Lev. 20:3). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their people (Ps. 148:14) will have clean hands and pure hearts; they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will not lift up their souls to an idol, nor swear deceitfully and they and their family (Acts 13:26) shall receive blessing from the Lord, and righteousness from the God of their salvation (Ps. 24:4-5). Our Children (Is. 61:9), shall abide in His tabernacle, and dwell in His holy hill (Ps. 15:1). Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) shall have a song and gladness of heart to come into the mountain of the Lord, to the mighty One of Israel (ls. 30:29). The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole, and the weaned child shall put their hand in the viper's den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all of His mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (is. 11:8-9). Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in His holy mountain (Ps. 48:1). God reigns over the nations: God sits on His holy throne (Ps. 47:8). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) exalt the Lord their God, and worship at His holy hill; for the Lord our God is holy (Ps. 99:9)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that

Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), shall seek the Lord and His strength; seek His face ever more, glory in His holy name and let their hearts rejoice (1 Chr. 16:10-11) for the joy of the Lord is their strength (Neh. 8:10). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) look to their maker, and their eyes will have respect for the Holy One of Israel (Is. 17:7). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), shall hear the words of the book, and their eyes shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness, that they shall increase their joy in the Lord and rejoice in the Holy One of Israel (Is. 29:18-19). Where they and their family (Acts 13:26) have erred in spirit they shall come to understanding, and where they have murmured they shall learn doctrine (ls. 29:24). In returning and rest shall they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be their strength (ls. 30:15). May the Lord give them and their people (Ps. 148:14) understanding according to His word (Ps. 119:169). Let the God of hope (Rom. 15:13) teach Our Children (Is. 61:9), and theirs His way so that they will walk in His truth; and unite their hearts to fear His name that they and their family (Acts 13:26) will glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:11-12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will rejoice in the Lord and give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name (Ps. 97:12) and triumph in His praise (Ps. 106:47), because they have trusted in His holy name (Zeph. 3:12). Let His mercy be upon Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 51:1), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). His praise endures forever (Ps. 111:10). The Lord God is their Father; their Redeemer from Everlasting is His name (ls. 63:16)! There is none holy like the Lord, for there is none besides Him, nor is there any rock like our God (1 Sam. 2:2)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), who manifested God's name to men (John 17:6), according to all that the Lord has bestowed on Our Children (Is. 61:9), and the great goodness toward their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), which He has bestowed on them according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (Is. 63:7), let the power of the Highest overshadow them (Luke 1:35) and their house (Luke 1:35). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that their heavenly Father will give (Luke 11:13) the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38), pouring out His Spirit on Our Children (Is. 61:9), and theirs abundantly through <u>Jesus Christ</u> their Savior (Titus 3:6) and the love of God also be poured out in their hearts by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 5:5). May the God of hope fill them and their family (Acts 13:26) with all joy and peace in believing, that they may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James

5:16) that the Helper (John 15:26), the Comforter the Holy Spirit (John 4:26), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:16-17), will teach Our Children (ls. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) all things and bring to their remembrance all things; that they will have the peace that only **Jesus** gives (John 14:26-27) and they may have His joy fulfilled in themselves (John 17:13). For their peace will be like a river, and their righteousness like the waves of the sea (Is. 48:18). According to His righteousness (Ps. 35:24) may the God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), the ways of life, that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will be full of joy in His presence (Acts 2:28), and bring them and their family (Acts 13:26) to His holy mountain, and make them and their people (Ps. 148:14) joyful in His house of prayer (Is. 56:7). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall put their trust in God and they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall possess the land, and shall inherit His holy mountain (Is. 57:13). Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) drink freely from the waters of life (Rev. 22:17). There shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; their house shall possess their possessions (Obad. 1:17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Jesus Christ will baptize Our Children (ls. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) with the Holy Spirit and with fire (Matt. 3:11), that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) may inherit the desolate heritage's (Is. 49:8). With His holy oil may the Lord anoint them and their people (Ps. 148:14) and by His hand they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall be established; by His arm they and their family (Acts 13:26) shall be strengthened. Their enemies shall not outwit them, nor the son of wickedness afflict them and their people (Ps. 148:14). God will beat down their foes before their face, and plague those who hate them and their house. His faithfulness and His mercy shall be with Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26), and in His holy name their horn shall be exalted (Ps. 89:20-24). His covenant shall stand firm with them (Ps. 89:28) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). For the Lord will go before Our Children (Is. 61:9), and the God of Israel will be their rear guard (Is. 52:12). Holy! Holy! Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come (Rev. 4:8)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), for they are washed, they are sanctified, they are justified in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11), in His precious name we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), be holy (Rev. 22:11) and receive the reward (Rev. 22:12), that they and their family (Acts 13:26) may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through

the gates into the city (Rev. 22:14). May Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) be people of holy conduct, godliness (2 Pet. 3:11) and honorable (1 Pet. 2:12). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14), of their own free will (Lev. 19:5), by the mercies of God present their bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God (Rom. 12:1), being transformed by the renewing of their minds (Rom. 12:2), sanctified by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:16), glorifying God in their body, mind, soul and spirit (1 Cor. 6:20) for the kingdom of God is not food and drink, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit (Rom. 14:17). As the elect of God, holy and beloved, may they and their family (Acts 13:26) put on tender mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, long suffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another (col. 3:12-13), putting on love which is the bond of perfection (col. 3:14) and let the peace of God rule in their hearts (Col. 3:15) and the word of *Christ* dwell in them richly in all wisdom (Col. 3:16). May they and their people (Ps. 148:14) be blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, nor violent, not greedy for money, but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, holy, self-controlled, holding fast the faithful word, being of sound doctrine (Titus 1:7-9). Remember Your covenant, O Lord (Ezek. 16:60)! In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Jehovah-Raah, the Lord our Shepherd (Ps. 23:1) will put His laws into their heart and in their mind He will write them. Their sins and their lawless deeds He will remember no more (Heb. 10:16-17). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) have the boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus (Heb. 9:12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) they and theirs will sanctify (Eph. 5:6) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and carry out the rubbish from the temple of the Holy Spirit, their bodies (1 Cor. 6:19). May they sanctify and cleanse themselves with the washing of water by the word, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that they should be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:26-27). Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having their hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and their bodies washed with pure water (Heb. 10:22). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their people (Ps. 148:14) gird up the loin of their minds, be sober, and rest their hope fully upon the grace of God (1 Pet. 1:13) laying aside all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor (Eph. 4:31), malice, quile, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking as newborn babes, desiring the pure milk of the word, that they may grow (1 Pet. 2:1-2); but also coming to the Lord as a living stone, being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 2:4-5); not using their liberty as a cloak for vice, but as servants of God (1 Pet. 2:16), acceptable to God and

approved by men (Rom. 14:18), that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) will be fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God (Eph. 2:19). Blessed be the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ*, who has blessed Our Children (Is. 61:9), with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in *Christ Jesus* (Eph. 1:3). HOLINESS TO THE LORD (Ex. 39:30)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13), whose name alone is the Lord, who is the Most-High over all the earth (Ps. 83:18), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), will not limit the Holy One of Israel, but remember His power (Ps. 78:41-42). His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him victory (Ps. 98:1). He has sent redemption to them and their family (Acts 13:26). He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name (Ps. 111:9)! The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding (Prov. 9:10). Being partakers of the heavenly calling (Heb. 3:1), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their people (Ps. 148:14) will have an anointing from the Holy One, and know all things (1 John 2:20), that light, insight, perception, intelligence, understanding, and wisdom be found in them and theirs (Dan. 5:11 Amp.). Let they and their family (Acts 13:26) build themselves up on their most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keeping themselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life (Jude 1:20-21). God has called Our Children (ls. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) with a holy calling, according to His own purpose and grace which was given to them in *Christ Jesus* before time began (2 Tim. 1-9). The grace of the *Lord* Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with them (2 cor. 13:14) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). And whatever they do in word or deed, let them and their family (Acts 13:26) do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Col. 3:17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) will see the glory of God (Acts 7:55) and with all boldness they will speak His word (Acts 4:29), for it is not them that speak but the Holy Spirit within them (Mark 13:11). According to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which is according to godliness (Titus 1:1), let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) go from strength to strength (Ps. 84:7) and walk in the fear of the Lord and the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31), serving *Christ* in these things and are acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:18). Our Children (Is. 61:9), and their family (Acts 13:26) be Holy People, the Redeemed of the Lord (ls. 62:12). May our Lord God consecrate them and

their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) may minister to Him as priests (Ex. 30:30). Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory (Is. 6:3)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord** Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan, 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in *Christ* (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that **Christ** might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and

<u>Christ</u> will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In <u>Christ</u> (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield belongs to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27) we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ, to bear His name (Acts 9;15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty **Psalms 89:34**. God is watching over His word to perform it Jerimiah. 1:12 and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it Isaiah 55:11. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word Joel 2:11! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms 33:1.** It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls Joel 2:32. "For My name shall be great among

the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! Amen and Amen! The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge (Ps. 19:1-2). The Lord shall reign forever – Our God, O Zion, to all generations. (Ps. 146:10). By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of Jesus Christ (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (ls. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
