The Divine Instinct

(Commonly referred to as *Sensus Divinitatis*)

All souls are endowed with a **Divine instinct**. All have the ability to commune with their heavenly Father. This sense is not learned and is not dependent on any religion, education or social environment. In short, it is not dependent on that which is of the external.
