CAKE & PIE CONTEST

- 1. EITHER One Cake or One Pie (not both) will be accepted.
- 2. Only currently enrolled 4-H and FFA members in good standing may enter.
- 3. Boosters may not enter.
- 4. The Pie or Cake must be checked in to the fair building office between 12:00pm and 1:00pm on MONDAY, July 31, 2023.
- 5. The Pie or Cake entered <u>must be made from scratch and entered in a disposable pie pan,</u> disposable cake pan or on a cardboard cake round.
- 6. A complete, printed or typed Recipe must be turned in with each entry and must include all ingredients, quantities and baking instructions. Any pie or cake turned in without a recipe will be disqualified.
- 7. Pies or Cakes requiring refrigeration will be accepted, but ONLY if the exhibitor has followed Food Safe Practices while transporting the pie or cake; (i.e. use of ice chest, ice, etc).
- 8. Entry Fee is \$5.00. Entries need to be made on-line on the ShoWorks Entry Portal July 1-15, 2023
- 9. A slice of each cake or pie, with the placing ribbons and recipes will be displayed during the Fair. The remaining cake or pie will be released Monday at 3:00pm and can be picked up after the completion of the judging. Anything left after 4:30pm on Monday will be given away.
- 10. The Grand Champion Pie and the Grand Champion Cake winners will be eligible to be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction on Friday night.
- 11. A fresh Pie or Cake must be made for the Auction, displayed and presented in a nice pie plate or cake server for the buyer. If your entry is purchased by more than one buyer, then the exhibitor has 30 days to deliver a freshly made cake or pie to all buyers.
