Here’s an opportunity for you to learn skills to become a career firefighter!

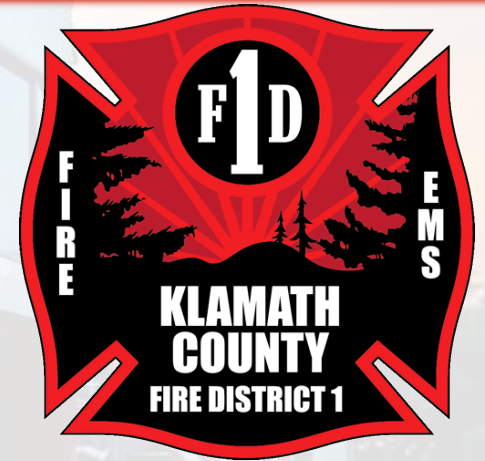

- ICS 100, 200, 700
- Technical Rescue
- NWCG Firefighter Type 2

- Valid driver’s license and acceptable driving record
- **Successfully complete background check**
