THE ENTRANCE ROAD AT THE CU OUTDOOR LABORATORY, HOME OF CAMP SERTOMA, IS A DRIVE OF BEAUTY. EXCELLENT PAVING AND SIGNAGE. CLEAN, TRASH-FREE BORDERS. LINED WITH MANY OLD GROWTH HARDWOODS WITH PINES MIXED IN. INCOMING CAMPERS ARE USUALLY BOTH NERVOUS AND WIDE-EYED, WONDERING WHAT IS AROUND THE NEXT CURVE. MANY OF THOSE SAME CAMPERS WILL BE TEARY AND SAD AS THEY DEPART CAMP 6 DAYS LATER ON THAT SAME ROAD.

THE ROAD HAS AN INTERESTING HISTORY. ONLY A SMALL PART OF IT TRAVELS ALONG THE ORIGINAL LOGGING PATH FROM THE ENTRANCE TO THE TURNAROUND AT THE LAKE, A DISTANCE JUST LESS THAN A MILE.
