LOOKING BACK JUST 10 DAYS AGO

A RECENT CAMP EVENT CAUSED ME TO SHIFT AWAY FROM MY PLANNED ARTICLE THIS MONTH. IT REMINDS US OF WHY WE DO WHAT WE DO, EVERY YEAR, TO FIND THOSE WHO NEED CAMP SERTOMA.

TWO DAYS BEFORE ONE OF MY CAMPERS, A 13-YEAR-OLD REPEAT TEEN, WAS SCHEDULED TO ATTEND THE FIRST SESSION, HER MOTHER CONTACTED ME. SHE SAID SOMETHING LIKE, "MR. WHITE, JANE (NOT REAL NAME) IS NOT GOING TO BE ABLE TO GO TO CAMP. SHE DOESN'T HAVE ENOUGH CLOTHES." WELL, WHAT DOES SHE NEED, I ASKED? AFTER GETTING THE SPECIFIC NEEDS AND SIZES AND CONTACTING MY CLUB PRESIDENT, MY WIFE, JUDY, AND I SET ABOUT FINDING WHAT SHE NEEDED. JUDY HAD SOME CLOTHES OF THE RIGHT SIZE, I FOUND OTHERS IN THE CAMP CLOTHES CLOSET, AND MADE A QUICK TRIP TO WAL-MART. THE PROBLEM WAS SOLVED, CLOTHES DELIVERED TO HER ON ARRIVAL DAY, AND SHE HAD A WONDERFUL LAST CAMP SERTOMA AS SHE AGED OUT FOR BEING ABLE TO RETURN.

THIS WAS NOT UNCOMMON FOR MANY OF YOU IN SERTOMA. WE DO WHAT WE NEED TO DO TO SERVE EVERY DESERVING CHILD WE FIND AND AFFORD IN OUR COMMUNITY WHO NEEDS CAMP SERTOMA. SOMETIMES, IT'S CLOTHES. SOMETIMES, IT'S PAYING FOR A PHYSICAL. SOMETIMES....WELL, WHATEVER IT TAKES.

A WEEK LATER, THE DAY BEFORE JANE'S DEPARTURE, THE MOTHER CALLED ME AGAIN. "HI. MR. WHITE, THIS IS (JANE'S MOM). I'M CALLING BECAUSE I DON'T KNOW IF I HAVE ENOUGH GAS TO COME AND GET JANE TOMORROW AND GET BACK HOME. I DON'T KNOW WHAT TO DO. DO YOU HAVE ANY SUGGESTIONS?" MY IMMEDIATE THOUGHT WAS TO PURCHASE A GIFT CARD (OUR CLUB DOES SUCH), DELIVER IT TO HER, PROBLEM SOLVED. HOWEVER, I CALLED HER, HAD A DISCUSSION, AND ASKED HER TO CALL ME BACK AND I WOULD NOT ANSWER. I ASKED HER TO LEAVE A VOICE MAIL, GIVING ME PERMISSION TO TAKE HER DAUGHTER HOME THE NEXT DAY.









I STILL PURCHASED A GIFT CARD, THINKING I MIGHT DONATE IT AFTER SEEING JANE'S LIVING ENVIRONMENT. I WANTED TO BE SURE OF NEED. JANE AND I TALKED ALL THE WAY TO LIBERTY, ABOUT 17 MILES AWAY, AT LEAST WHEN SHE WAS NOT CRYING ABOUT LEAVING CAMP AND HER SPECIAL CABIN COUNSELOR FRIEND.


HER LIVING ENVIRONMENT WAS A JOLT OF REALISM. A RAMSHACKLED MOBILE HOME, 3 SINGLE ADULTS AND JANE LIVING THERE ALONG WITH 7 DOGS AND 2 RABBITS, THE INTERIOR BARELY LIVABLE. THE ONLY MAN THERE THANKED ME AND THEN BOLDLY ASKED IF I KNEW SOMEONE WHO COULD FIX HIS ROTTED KITCHEN FLOOR. I'M STILL THINKING ABOUT THAT QUESTION. JANE AND I SAID GOODBYE. I LEFT THE GIFT CARD, HOPEFULLY FOR HER USE, BUT WHO KNOWS?

I FELT BOTH SUPER SAD FOR HER AND THANKFUL AT THE SAME TIME, KNOWING THAT SHE HAD EXPERIENCED 2 WONDERFUL SUMMERS AT CAMP SERTOMA AND WAS ALREADY THINKING ABOUT FUTURE EMPLOYMENT THERE. WHERE IS HER LIFE HEADED? DID CAMP MAKE A DIFFERENCE? WHAT DID CAMP GIVE HER THAT SHE WOULDN'T EXPERIENCE IN HER HOME SITUATION? HER HOME LIFE AND HER CAMP LIFE WERE AT OPPOSITE ENDS OF A COMFORT, CARING, AND HEALTHY SPECTRUM. YOU GET THE PICTURE, RIGHT?

ANY SERTOMAN ANYWHERE WOULD HAVE RESPONDED TO THE MOTHER AND CHILD'S NEEDS AS I DID. IT'S SERVICE TO MANKIND. SOMETIMES, HOWEVER, IT CAN SHAKE ONE TO THE CORE WHEN WE HEAR AND SEE WHAT MANY OF OUR DESERVING CHILDREN EXPERIENCE EVERY DAY. AS I STARTED THIS STORY, I CLOSE IT THE SAME WAY. AS SERTOMANS, "THIS IS WHY WE DO WHAT WE DO."
