DOWAGIAC ELKS: IMPORTANT – VENUE CHANGE! Because of snow on the trails we cannot hike at Madeline Bertrand Park as foot traffic is not allowed on cross country ski trails. I am making a change with two dynamite options. We will meet at the *Dowagiac Elks Lodge* for the lecture and start. Everyone can choose the topic(s) you need.

HIKE OPTION 1: Hike The Jack

This is a great urban hike with a special bonus. This course explores beautiful *Sculptures in the City*, and historic mansions. As an added bonus the *Ice Festival* is being held in downtown Dowagiac. The course offers hikes of 10.0, 7.1 and 6.0 miles set up on plowed streets and sidewalks. You will navigate this interesting course with a map and a handout with course highlights. At the finish you will receive a *Pathfinder Award* certificate. As an added bonus our aid station will be *Olympia Books*, owned by my son Jeff, in downtown Dowagiac.

HIKE OPTION 2: Roadrunner Trails, 9.0 miles

The Roadrunner Trails are snow covered but hike-able if there is no unforeseen storm between now and Saturday. We plan to mark the course with florescent red paint only (look for arrows, but not signs) just before the hike. Please don't start early as there will be no arrows. Cleats and poles are highly recommended. Aid station at the Middle School.

DIRECTIONS: MAP LINKS to the Elks Lodge in your email. (corner of Riverside Dr. & Hill St.)

REHYDRATION: I suggest a great new restaurant, the *Oak and Ash* barbecue in downtown Dowagiac (by the light, across from Shell and you park in the rear off Depot Drive.) Note: It's in the old *Zeke's Restaurant* location. (Map link in your email)
