HIKE THE JACK! Our next hike will be my *Hike The Jack* tour of the eleven beautiful sculptures and two historic mansions of Dowagiac plus a scenic loop on a quiet gravel road around the Mill Pond. This is an alternate hike for our scheduled Roadrunner Trails hike. The trails are covered with snow and the forecast does not bode well for using the trails. We will still meet at the Elks Club and we will have a social distance start between 9:00 and 10:00AM.

LECTURE: I plan on doing an outdoor lecture in the parking lot from 9:00AM to 9:30AM. The lecture topic will be HOF Tear and Repair training and comments on the Grand Canyon Trip Itinerary. I will ask those attending the lecture to social distance and mask.
