REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS

The following items are required of students while participating in clinicals at EMTC Please specify dates.

- 1. TB Evaluation (tuberculosis)
 - a. Negative PPD within 1 (one) year, or
 - b. Positive PPD with negative chest X-ray, or
 - c. History of a positive PPD with a negative chest X-ray and treatment with appropriate anti-tubercular drugs or
 - d. Physician instructions about alternative treatment
- 2. Rubella (German measles) Persons under the age of 45 must demonstrate:
 - a. A positive Rubella Titer (greater than 10) or
 - b. Two doses of MMR after 15 months of age
 - c. A physician diagnosed history of Rubella (indicate date of illness)
- 3. Rubeola (Hard or American Measles)
 - a. Born prior to 1957, or
 - b. Physician diagnosed history of rubeola (indicate date of illness), or
 - c. Two doses of vaccine after 15 months of age
- 4. Varicella Zoster (Chicken Pox)
 - a. A positive history of chicken pox (include date of illness), or
 - b. If no history of chicken pox, obtain a varicella zoster titer
 - c. If the titer indicates no immunity, complete the immunization series for varicella zoster
- 5. Hepatitis B Vaccine
 - a. Received 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine, and a positive hep B SA6 titer
 - b. In the process of completing the series of 3 doses, or
 - c. A signed declination statement
- 6. Immunization status should be readily available in the clinical setting.
- 7. It is also strongly recommended that all students and faculty have health care insurance coverage. Students and faculty assume financial responsibility for their own medical care.
- 8. Influenza Vaccine
 - a. Received the current year of influenza vaccine
 - b. A signed declination statement
- 9. Mumps
 - a. Born prior to 1957, or
 - b. Physician diagnosed history of rubeola (indicate date of illness), or
 - c. Two doses of vaccine after 15 months of age
